Street lights/STD

As many of you know, we have petitioned the County to create a new Special Tax District (STD). If you haven't already, you will soon receive a mailing from the County with information about that petition. Most of the information included in the package simply ticks off a check mark required by Maryland State Law. **Here are the important points:**

- The new STD reduces the amount you will pay from \$150 per lot/per year to \$115 per lot/per year. It shifts most budgeted expenses to Operations and Capital categories. This means that a very small amount of your payment will go to Administrative costs, and most of the money will go to paying roads.
- The Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on June 30, 2016 at the Southern Pines Community Center at 7 p.m. Please plan to attend to voice your opinion.

One more thing; we did get an unwanted surprise in that the County decided to transfer the cost of the street lights along our public use roads to us. They had been paying for these eighty-some lights for some time and now have demanded that we pay the cost starting July 1. We were caught off guard by this, having been told that it was not going to happen. As a result, we were not able to fund the payment of this expense in the STD petition or in our overall budget. We will have to pay this unfunded cost in the coming fiscal year without it being in the budget.

Beach cameras

As the picture below indicates, we do have cameras installed at the beach. The cameras are there to protect the community. We have been able to provide evidence to the Sheriff's department to help prosecute criminal behavior and will continue to provide this important community service.
