Training

Job Description

Your Job

As an adjuster you will do a variety of things. If you do not have experience this is ok. The industry is designed to train you for all you need to know in a short amount of time.

You will assess insurance claims. Document with photos and drawings. Write and submit a report to the insurance company and get paid.

Your Path

The path to becoming an adjuster is also multifaceted but it all begins with the All Lines Adjuster license.

Your state may not offer this so you will need to get what is called a nonresident license from one of 3 states. TX, IN or FL. Depending on your focus to either work from home, W2 or 100% freelance you will need further certification. The cost all depends who you use.

Your Pay

What you can expect as a new adjuster depends on who you work for. W2 employees can look at a starting wage of 50K annually. If you want to go independent, you can earn from 40K part time to 120K full time.

If you really want to change your financial future and you are willing to travel and train, then your income can exceed 150K
