The Law Enforcement D.R.A.W. School **Advanced Patrol Rifle Instructor** development course is a 3-day, 36-hour instructor course that covers both basic and advanced shooting and instructional skills. Candidates must complete a 6-hour online prerequisite course before attending. Candidates do NOT have to be an APOSTC certified firearms instructor to attend this course. Graduates of the course must submit copies of their D.R.A.W. School Advanced Patrol Rifle Instructor certification and assessment to APOSTC for approval and to receive 36-hours of CEUs.
