BASIC PATROL RIFLE INSTRUCTOR

Then students hit the range for a full day of practical shooting skills, training and refreshers, including:

- Mastering proper balance using the D.R.A.W. Stance
- Mastering fast and accurate shooting out to distance
- Mastering fast emergency reloading sequences
- Mastering tactical reloading and knowing when to use it
- Mastering shooting on the move with lateral movements
- Mastering shooting on the move with linear movements
- Mastering shoulder and weapons transitions
- Mastering primary and secondary hand operations

ADVANCED PATROL RIFLE INSTRUCTOR
