Companies moved away from traditional degree requirements and instead focusing on critical skills.

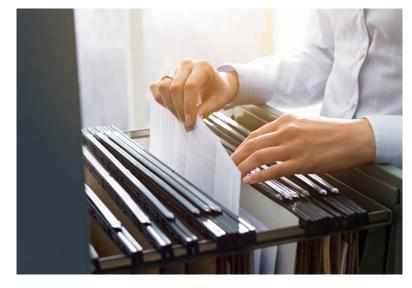
What you can do now:

#2 Hybrid Working

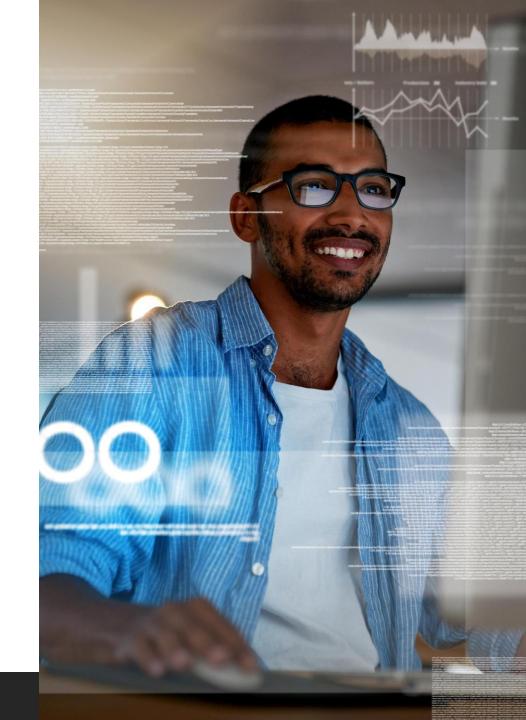
Organizations will be able to steal talent from RTO companies due to inflexible policies.

#3 Al and Hiring

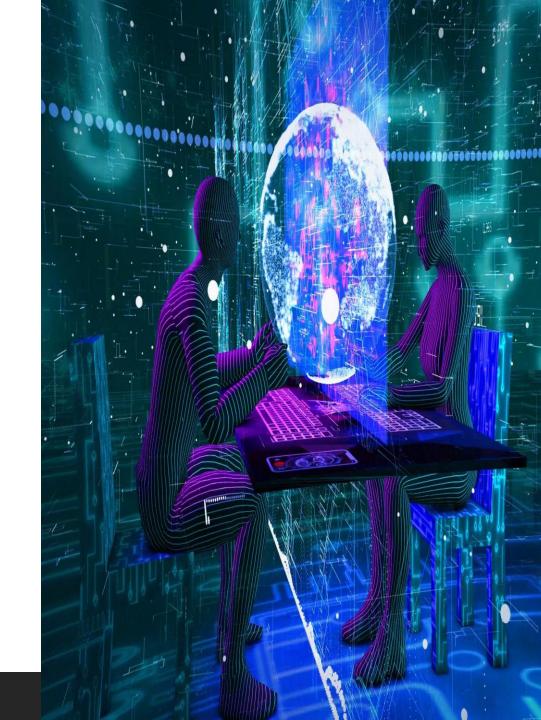
Al is embedded in some places like LinkedIn. In most places it's really recruiting automation.

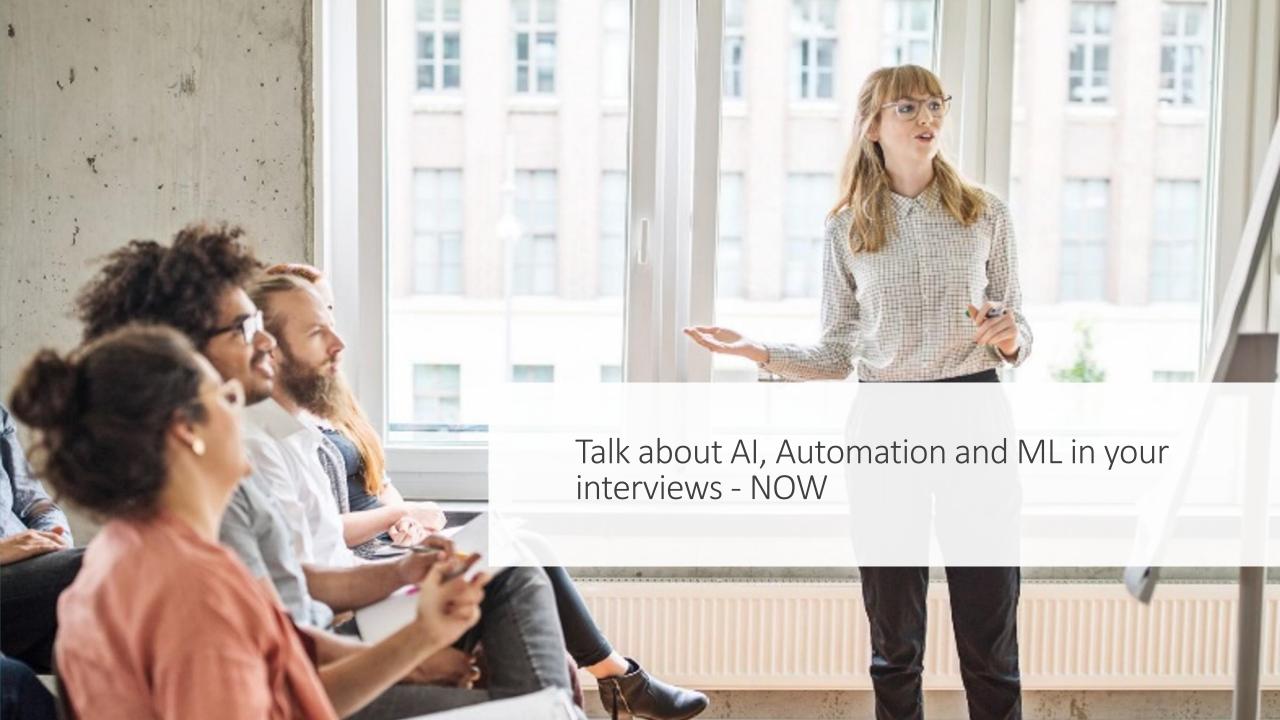
What this means:
