# THE VALUE of OUR LAKES

It's hard to deny the value of Kosciusko County's lakes. As natural sources of beauty and recreation, they draw thousands of tourists annually. But what is their exact value to our community, in dollars and cents? The Center for Lakes & Streams conducted an economic impact study to find out. Using data collected from 314 businesses along with public data sources and national averages, they arrived at the figures below.
