- 1. **Executive Session:** 19:00 19:21
  - 1. Opening and "Sunrise Channel" proposal Ed
    - Ed opened meeting by discussing "Sunrise Channel" proposal
    - Ed shared concerns whether the proposal is a one-time cost and how effective the investment would be since we still do not have all data from lake health surveys
    - Jeff confirmed he forwarded the proposal to Enviroscience
    - Jeff will forward the proposal to Lake Savings/Tucci for review and feedback
    - Ed suggested we table the vote until the full board is available to properly vet. Jeff, Matt and Rick agreed
  - 2. Use of ALA "Work boat" by ASHA Ed
    - Ed shared concerns about the "work which could or will be performed" while using the ALA Work boat.
    - Requested ASHA (Jim Prohaska requester) provide a letter confirming the ASHA user of the Work boat have the appropriate insurance coverage via ASHA and confirms ALA will be held harmless
    - Rick confirmed he would review with Jim Prohaska
    - Note: on or about Friday, July 13<sup>th</sup> Mr. Jim Prohaska stopped at Rick's house – at which point Rick shared the Boards request for a "letter confirming appropriate insurance and verbiage ALA will be held harmless." Mr. Prohaska confirmed his understanding and advised he (and ASHA) are still waiting for the "dump trailer" to arrive
  - 3. Sailboats / Traffic pattern Ed
    - Ed shared concerns with traffic pattern
    - Board agreed to postpone discussions until full board available.
      Added to "ALA Parking Lot" below
- 2. **General Session:** 19:22 20:10
  - 1. Ed (and ALA Board) welcomed the following guests:

- Mr. Sam Alonso, Mayor of Reminderville invited RE "California Project"
- Emanuel Viant, Hawthorne homeowner invited RE "Sunrise Cove Project"
- William Thompson, Hawthorne homeowner invited RE "Sunrise Cove Project"

#### 2. Ed deferred the floor to Mr. Sam Alonso

- Sam started by confirming the 40" pipe run from Aurora side then being dumped into Aurora Lake have been "nixed". He continued by sharing updated plans...
- Project monies will be used to pave California street with concrete
- Retention pond behind "Reuben's house" on Nautilus...
  - Holds about a football field worth of water
  - Will stay about 2' level from bottom of retention pond
  - Over 2' it would simply overflow into neighboring brook which does not enter lake
- Sam shared the "Park System" took Pond brook and made it into an "S" turn versus having it running straight...planned overflow/flooding to "recharge the wetlands"
- Sam advised "experts" from Michigan have been invited to evaluate storm water from surrounding areas to develop mitigation plans. He did not share a date/timeline
- Sam referred to the "water being pumped into the channel" as a permanent solution if he can't get support/buy-in from surrounding communities (Twinsburg, Solon, Bainbridge, etc) to help with the flooding in Aurora Shores
- Sam continued by stating he has a team "designing a filtration system" for the Pump which would then add "clean water" to the Aurora Shores channel (located behind the houses at the end of Crows Nest Cove)
- Sam shared there is an area behind Bainbridge shopping center which could help to contain water/sediment during periods of heavy rainfall...
  - A levy would been to be build up by the adjacent roadway

- Sam invited Army Corp of Engineers to evaluate
- Sam confirmed his service department (or other service) is helping to locate and eradicate Beaver dams downstream to help mitigate water backup/flooding. Eradicating Beaver dams is an ongoing issue
- Sam went back to discussing California street...he was able to get a six (6) month extension to use the money to...
  - Pave and create berm edges on California street
  - Confirmed "no water would be directed/or enter Nautilus trail it would simply flow into Pond Brook
- Sam shared a few names that could potentially assist with Lake Health efforts...
  - Bob Gibbs/Congressman
    - Obtains tom of \$ to assist with funding for Lake Erie Dredging efforts
  - David Joyce/Congressman/Aurora
- Lake Health Jeff (while we were still discussing "California project"...
  - Shared that perhaps we could partner with the Mayor to use the results to help inform surrounding communities of their impact
  - Although a private lake, it's a "Public Retention basin to contain runoff" – need to further explore options...
  - Mayor Sam Alonso departed...

3. Sunrise Cove Project – Ed/Emanuel (commence at 19:46)

- Ed opened discussion and turned over to Emanuel
- Emanuel shared background on Project/request for \$2,100
  - Introduce beneficial bacteria
  - \$2,100 for three (3) acres
  - Area behind "Sweet Grass, referred to as Sunrise Cove" is roughly three (3) acres
  - Ed queried impact to "fish/plant life" Emanuel shared he is not aware of any ill-effects
  - Emanuel suggested the "Sunrise Cove" project could be a "beta test" for potential use on larger lake area...believes cost would be significantly less than (~400 acres x \$700 = \$280,000) due to different application
- Ed thanked Emanuel and William for their interest with improving the Lake Health. Advised we would review with the Board at upcoming meeting to determine next steps
- 4. Lake Testing Matt
  - Confirmed he will conduct testing and share results with Board (now that the majority of algae has dissipated)
  - Advised he will test similar areas to understand current levels then post update to inform Homeowners
- 3. Parking Lot: Items which need further discussion/consideration
  - 1. Safety Officer Job Posting (ref attachment "A" dated April 11, 2018)
    - Jerry to post on ALA and Facebook for 2-3 weeks
    - Invite 2-3 candidates to May ALA Board meeting for interviews
  - 2. Repair Hawthorne boat ramp (Fall of 2018)\*added from April 2018 meeting
  - Suggestion during Feb 2018 ALA board mtg to create rule regarding movement of any navigational markers/buoys, impact to safety and discipline
  - 4. \*Combination of "fish derby" with men's club summer party transform into "Summerfest"?

- 5. \*Common sense safe boating class (Jerry sent draft to Board after Feb 2018 mtg)
- 6. \*Extend Community service hours to high school kids
- 7. \*Create a checklist of seasonal operations for future boards include document to be renewed every five (5) years
  - State of Ohio business document no. 201713003180
- 8. Water Testing communication of E-coli results
- 9. "Ballast boats" Jerry shared thoughts on behalf of John Milner (from June 2018 ALA mtg)
  - Concern: There is an increasing number of "Ballast boats
  - Put item on hold and discuss at future ALA meeting to consider placing limits on the number of "Ballast boats"
- 10. Sailboats traffic pattern
  - Added to parking lot from July 11, 2018 ALA mtg)
