**What is the Child Medical Collaborative, Inc.?**

The Child Medical Collaborative, Inc. (CMC) was formed initially by three child advocacy centers (CACs) – AWAKE in Jackson County, KARE in Haywood County, and KIDS Place in Macon County. We began collaborating because children who were victims of abuse were often unable to receive timely child medical evaluations at CACs due to a variety of reasons. These include the difficulty to hire and retain medical providers, funding gaps, and the challenge to bill Medicaid as individual CACs. With the number of child abuse victims soaring, AWAKE, KARE, and KIDS Place decided to collaborate for a solution and provide victims with timely, efficient, and healing child medical evaluations – resulting in the formation of the CMC, Inc. Currently, The CMC contracts with a supervising medical provider, three mid-level providers, and a program manager. The CMC is a pilot program. This is not just an opportunity for employment, but a chance to change lives forever.
