Obtain and submit professional engineer certification that any proposed activity in a regulatory floodway
will not result in any increase in the regulatory flood elevation.
Prepare and submit pre- and post-construction Elevation Certificates.
Submit copies of PA DEP permit(s) for proposed activity in a regulatory floodway.
