Exemplification Ceremony



Thursday March 25th our Degree team presided over an Exemplification Ceremony at St Anthony of Padua Church in East Northport. This was the first in-person exemplification to be held in our district since the health crisis, and our team performed outstandingly, to the point where the team has received an invitation to take its show on the road, and hold an Exemplification May 19th.

As most of you are aware, the Exemplification Ceremony remains a solemn and serious one, but has been updated to be more accurate with our times. Specifically while in the past there three separate ceremonies for the first three degrees of Knighthood, now all the lessons for the first three degrees are presented in one Exemplification, leaving only the Fourth (Patriotic) degree as a separate ceremony. Another departure from the past is that spouses or guests are welcome at the ceremony, although in order to be able to reduce the number of people present and allow social distancing we ask that each individual undergoing Exemplification limit themselves to one or two guests.
