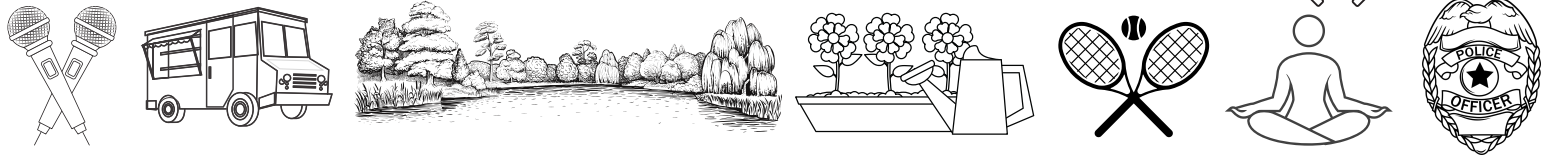


Hello Sylvan Lake Residents,

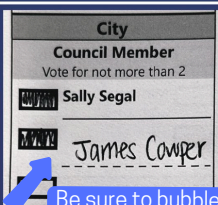
