



ACSOQ MEDAL CLASSES specifications

To be shown over a hunter-type course with a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional, and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Two tests to be included in the course. No flat phase.

Riders may not enter more than one ACSOQ Medal class at the same show. One rider per horse/pony. To be judged using open numerical scoring with scores to be announced. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count.

The top 20 riders in each Medal will be invited to compete in the ACSOQ Medal Finals. At Finals, additional testing of top four riders is mandatory.

ACSOQ PONY MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders on ponies who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class. Small Ponies 2'3", Medium Ponies 2'6" and Large Ponies 2'9".

ACSOQ CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders on horses that are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". Fences 3'.

ACSOQ JUNIOR MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders on horses. Fences 3'6".

ACSOQ ADULT MEDAL

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses. Fences to 3'.
