The PMoC Transitional Home will become operational on September 1st, 2021 and will be the first of its kind for the SDA church in South Carolina. We give Praises to God for His guidance and His faithful servants in the Carolina churches, our servant leaders of the Carolina Conference and the Southern Union and North American Division Prison Ministries servants, all of whom have contributed.

Thus we will begin the next phase of the ministry, Project Our Brothers Keeper, the burden given to Brother William Morgan by our Father in Heaven, to provide a place of SDA biblically based healing, training and acclimation for the forgotten and institutionalized with no positive environments in which to return. Our goal, with your help, is to provide a 1st class SDA environment for these men to begin their journey back into society. NOTE: Funds have been allocated for a memorial to Brother William (Bill) Chaney who tirelessly worked to help realize God's mission given to Brother Bill Morgan, to reach our oft forgotten Brothers. We are requesting a group of volunteers, friends and acquaintances of Brother Bill, who would donate time and talent to design and install a small memorial garden (10' x 10") with a sitting bench in the yard at the home. Volunteers can contact Linda or your church PMoC representative to sign up and be prepared to install the garden during one or both of the work bees on 7/25 or 8/22.

In closing, the transitional home will now require a monthly operating budget of \$2,000.00, the ministry is prepared for the following 2-3 months after opening. However, we are seeking 8 churches/individuals to commit to a \$250.00 per month offering for the Operational Fund. This ongoing offering will pay for monthly expenses such as electricity, insurance, groceries, & educational training materials, and other operational expenses.

Our High Priest, Jesus Christ has commissioned his followers to go the forgotten, so we ask all of you to be involved in this effort and we praise God for your faithfulness.
