

YOUR GUIDE TO THE DRIVER'S LICENSE RESTORATION PROCESS



BEFORE YOUR FIRST VISIT

Please gather the following documents:

- ☐ Request for Hearing form (completed)
- ☐ Michigan Driving Record from the Secretary of State (available for \$16 at michigan.gov/SOSonline)
- ☐ Criminal History through ICHAT (available for \$10 at apps.michigan.gov)
- ☐ 3–6 Community Support Letters from friends, family, or people in the community
- ☐ Evidence of Support – Sign in Sheets from AA and/or NA (if applicable)
- ☐ Letter/Certificate from Probation stating completion/graduation (if applicable)
- ☐ Documentation from all SUD treatment providers (if applicable)
- ☐ BAIRD report from Smart Start/Interlock device within the past 30 days (if applicable)
- ☐ Prescription information form for any behavioral health medication (if applicable)
- ☐ SOS Drivers License Hearing Denial letter (if applicable)



COMMUNITY SUPPORT LETTERS

Letters may come from:

- Family
- Friends
- Employers
- Clergy
- Sponsors
- Others familiar with your sobriety



Each letter must be signed in front of a notary.

RSU provides notary services free of charge for our assessment clients.



YOUR FIRST VISIT – WALK INS WELCOME

Monday–Thursday • 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM

At your first visit, you will:

- ✓ Bring all of your documentation
- ✓ Complete the required 12-panel urine drug screen
- ✓ Complete a brief self-evaluation
- ✓ Schedule your assessment appointment



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Most applicants are expected to demonstrate at least one year of continuous abstinence before beginning the restoration process.
- Your assessment must be completed within 30 days of your drug screen.
- If more than 30 days pass, another drug screen (\$35) is required.



ASSESSMENT APPOINTMENT

Approximately 2 hours.

Please arrive on time. If you arrive more than 10 minutes late, your appointment must be rescheduled.
