

ZIEBACH COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

MAY 5TH, 2026

The Ziebach County Commissioners met in regular session at 1:00 PM with Rick Farlee, David Pesicka, Shane Farlee, Tucker Stocklin, Bill Henderson present. Chairman Rick Farlee called the meeting to order.

MINUTES: Comm. David Pesicka moved to approve the April 8th and Equalization minutes as presented with the understanding that the wrong minutes were published last month and corrections that the corrected minutes will be posted in the paper, seconded by Comm. Shane Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: NONE

NEW BUSINESS: Rick asked the board to look into buying/leasing a tractor for the highway department. Comm. T. Stocklin moved to advertise for a bid to either lease or buy a tractor 165/185M brand new or used with 2500-5000 hours that is a 140-170, seconded by Comm. D. Pesicka, all voted aye, motion carried. The ad will run in the paper next week.

GAS QUOTES: The following quotes for gas were received: Agtegra– SNL Gas, \$3.79; Farmer’s Union Oil –NL Gas – Pump price minus Federal tax - SNL Gas, Pump price minus Federal tax. Comm. S. Farlee

moved to accept the quote from Agtegra, seconded by Comm. B. Henderson, all voted aye, motion carried.

FUEL QUOTES: The Highway Department called for quotes for #2 dyed diesel (2,000 Gal.) on April 14, 2026. The following quotes were received: Agtegra - #2 Dyed DSL, \$3.99; Farmers Union Oil - #2 Dyed DSL, \$3.91. The quote from Farmers Union Oil Co was accepted.

MOU WITH SDSU-KYLE BEACH: Kyle spoke to the board about clarification on how the authority order goes for our 4-h advisor. For anything that involves funding and hours the order goes Corinna than Commissioners. For anything involves 4-H it goes Corinna then Kyle then SDSU.

SECURITY CAMERA : Shane Penfield contacted Teigen Clark about a possible quote to do a new security system for the courthouse and highway shop. They will be presenting a quote at next month's meeting.

APPROVAL OF PLAT MAP: CLARK ADDITION. Comm. D. Pesicka motioned to approved of the Clark Addition Plat Map on contingent that Assurance will provide an original for the commissioners to sign, seconded by Comm. Shane Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried.

CENTRAL SOUTH DAKOTA ENHANCEMENT DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER APPOINTMENT: Comm. D. Pesicka moved to appoint Commissioner Shane Farlee as the Central South Dakota Enhancement District to serve as a board member from Ziebach County, seconded by Comm. T. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion carried.

PRAIRIE DOG: SHANE PENFIELD – Shane Penfield let the commissioners know that Bernie Anderson thanking him for doing his part. The commissioners asked for Mr. Penfield to send a letter to the remaining neighbors to do their part in getting rid of the prairie dog problem.

BUTLER CAT/RDO(JOHN DEERE): Unfortunately no one from either location was able to come talk to the commissioners so they decided to table the discussion until next month. Comm. S. Farlee motioned to table the payment and discussion until next month, seconded by Comm. T. Stocklin, all voted ayes, motion carried.

HIGHWAY REPORT: Jeff Jensen, Highway Superintendent, presented his written report before the board. He mentioned multiple complaints that he received from civilians. One of the roads that he received a complaint on was not within county jurisdiction and therefore was not the county's responsibility to maintain. Jeff also asked the board if there was a way they could purchase a 1000 gal. fuel tank to place in the north part of the county to eliminate a highway employee from having to drive back and forth every time he needed to fuel up. Comm. T. Stocklin motioned for Jeff to purchase a 1000 gal. fuel tank to set up north for the highway department to use, seconded by Comm. D. Pesicka, all voted ayes, motioned carried. Jeff also informed the commissioners he will need to purchase a set of shanks to mount the packers on the back of the blades.

SHERIFF REPORTS: Gary Cudmore, Sheriff, presented the monthly vehicle reports to the Board. With the warmer weather, criminal activity has increased. The Sheriff anticipates more activity in the future as summer begins.

OTHER BUSINESS: There was a request for a liquor license from the county for May 30th and June 26th-28th from the Pioneer Days Rodeo Committee, but since it was not on the agenda they could not approve it this time it will need to be advertised for 2 weeks then the commissioners will hold a special meeting to approve it on May 27th, 2026 via telephone.
