## **JANUARY 2, 2024**

The Ziebach County Commissioners met in regular session at 2:00 PM with Shane Farlee, David Pesicka, Rick Farlee and Tucker Stocklin present. Bill Henderson absent. Chairman R. Farlee called the meeting to order.

Comm. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion carried. Rick Farlee will serve as Chairman for 2024. The Auditor

called for nominations for Vice-Chairman for 2024. Comm. Pesicka nominated Tucker Stocklin,

seconded by Comm. S. Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried. Tucker Stocklin will serve as Vice-Chairman

for 2024.

**MEETINGS:** The Ziebach County Commissioners shall meet the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of Each Month, unless

otherwise noted.

**DESIGNATIONS:** Comm. Stocklin moved to leave the following designations as is, seconded by Comm.

S. Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried.

- 1. The Official Newspaper for Ziebach County will be the West River Eagle.
- 2. The Official Depository for Ziebach County will be the 1<sup>st</sup> Financial Bank, Dupree.
- 3. The Courthouse parking lot, the first floor of the Courthouse and the County Highway

Department yards are places to hold chattel mortgage sales.

**FUND INVESTMENT:** Comm. S. Farlee moved to authorize the County Treasurer to invest all idle funds to gain maximum interest for the benefit of Ziebach County, in accordance with SDCL 4-5-8. Seconded by Comm. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion carried.

**MILEAGE & PERDIEM:** Comm. Stocklin moved to set mileage and perdiem at the current state rates, except that actual costs for lodging will be allowed with board approval; and the mileage charged by the Sheriff for serving papers will be set at 6 cents over current state rates. Seconded by Comm. Pesicka, all voted aye, motion carried.

**ELECTION FEES:** Comm. S Farlee moved to set the fee for election officials at \$15.00 per hour for hours worked, current state mileage for delivery of election supplies and results, and a \$30.00 attendance fee for election school. Seconded by Comm. Pesicka, all voted aye, motion carried.

**BURIAL FEES:** Comm. Pesicka moved to set the indigent burial fee paid by the County at \$1600 plus mileage not to exceed a maximum of \$2000, seconded by Comm. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion carried. **MACHINE HIRE RATES:** Comm. Pesicka moved to set hourly machine hire rates as follows, seconded by Comm. Shane Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried:

SALARIES: Discussion was held on wage raises for 2024. As raises were included in the budget for 2024,

Comm. Stocklin moved to give a \$1.00 per hour raise or the equivalent thereto - \$2340.00 per year,

seconded by Comm. Pesicka, all vote aye, motion carried. The fee for Emergency Manager, V.S.O., and

Coroner will remain the same. The Commissioners will receive \$546.00 per month. Salaries will be set as

**MINUTES:** Comm. Pesicka moved to approve the December 28, 2023 minutes as presented. Seconded by Comm. S. Farlee. All ayed. Motion carried.

**New Business:** The commission granted approval for the Highway Department to attend the required annual Mine Safety Health Act Training January 17<sup>th</sup>, in Mobridge, SD.

**FUEL QUOTES:** The following quotes for gas were received: Agtegra – SNL Gas, \$2.35 Farmers Union Oil Co. – NL Gas, \$2.54; SNL Gas, \$2.19 Comm. Stocklin moved to accept the bid from Farmers Union Oil Co. for SNL Gas at \$2.19, seconded by Comm. S. Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried.

HWY. DEPT. REPORT: Casey Gage, Highway Superintendent, gave a brief update to the board.

**Parking Lot Bids:** The parking lot bids have been tabled, until they receive the bid booklet from Kyle with Brosz. Engineering.

**Culvert Bids:** Commissioner Stocklin motioned to have Jerome Miller do the labor for the replacement of the culvert near Mike Maher's place at the cost of \$5,500. Seconded by Commissioner S. Farlee. All ayed. Motion carried.

**Gravel Truck Liner:** The board discussed getting gravel truck liners to aid in hauling gravel through the winter. The commission and the highway superintendent will investigate further. No decisions were made. Further discussion will be had in the next meeting.

**SHERIFF'S REPORT:** Gary Cudmore, Sheriff reported on law enforcement activities. He was granted permission to purchase an infrared thermal 360° safety radar that will mount on top of their pickup. This will help tremendously in search and rescue efforts. It will cost approximately \$3,000. WarHawk Emergency Management District will reimburse up to half of the cost. He also presented his monthly

vehicle reports to the Board. The Board discussed purchasing security cameras for the Highway Shop. Sheriff Cudmore said that he would look into it and get back with the board in February's meeting.

2024 INSURANCE RENEWAL: Dick and Karen Butler, Butler Insurance Agency presented the 2024

insurance renewal package for Ziebach County to the Board. This includes Property, Inland Marine,

Auto, Law Enforcement and all Liability policies for a total premium of \$56,644.00. Comm. Pesicka

moved to accept the 2024 Insurance Package with Employers Mutual Insurance Company through Butler

Insurance Agency, without terrorism coverage. Seconded by Comm. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion

carried.

Executive Session: : Shane Farlee moved to go into executive session at 3:50 PM to discuss personnel,

seconded by Dave Pesicka, all voted aye, motion cared. Olivia Dosch, Shane Penfield, and Casey Gage

were also present. The Board came out of executive session at 3:54 PM.
