## BRIDGE REINSPECTION PROGRAM RESOLUTION FOR USE WITH SDDOT RETAINER CONTRACTS

**WHEREAS,** 23 CFR 650 Subpart C, requires initial inspection of all bridges and reinspection at intervals not to exceed two years with the exception of reinforced concrete box culverts that meet specific criteria. These culverts are reinspected at intervals not to exceed four years.

**THEREFORE**, Ziebach County is desirous of participating in the Bridge Inspection Program.

The County requests SDDOT to hire Brosz Engineering Inc. (Consulting Engineers) for the inspection work. SDDOT will secure federal approvals, make payments to the Consulting Engineer for inspection services rendered, and bill the County for 20% of the cost. The County will be responsible for the required 20% matching funds.

SHERIFF'S REPORTS: Mike Deneui, Deputy Sheriff presented the monthly vehicle reports to the Board.

**ASSESSMENTS:** Misty Williams, Assessor reported on the Non-Ag assessments being worked on throughout the County. These assessments will bring Ziebach County closer to compliance with market value.

## RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING OFFICE POLICY FOR PUBLIC INFORMATION ACCESS AND PRICING SCHEDULE FOR DIRECTOR OF EQUALIZATION'S OFFICE

Whereas, recent requests for computer generated copies of public information in the Ziebach County assessment records have prompted the need for establishing office policy and pricing;

Whereas, there is an inherent cost not only to generate records but to maintain records;

Now therefore, be is resolved that the following fee schedule be established:

Hard Copies of Information - \$1.00 per page (copied by requester, during regular business hours)

Computer-Generated Records – via email \$1000.00

GIS Geodatabase - \$4000.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a request for computer-generated public records form must be filed & approved, a completed product license agreement must be filed and full payment must be received before release of records. Ziebach County reserves the right to share data with other governmental/public entities.

EMC RISK IMPROVEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS: The Board reviewed the Recommendations for Improvement

made by our insurance carrier, EMC Insurance: Repair back parking lot and sidewalk along Main Street; Develop

business continuity plan; Repairs gutters on County Shop; Inspect and repair exterior plug-in receptacle near bulk

fuel containment; and Obtain flammable storage cabinet to be used at County Shop. Ziebach County will obtain

estimates and work to correct the items listed.

ALERT SENSE: Cody Birkeland, Dupree Voluntary Fireman explained the Alert Sense notifying system which the

Dupree Fire Department uses, to the Board. They are asking if Ziebach County would be interested in using this

system for alerts and sharing the cost with the Dupree Fire Department and the Glad Valley Fire Department.

With a 3-way split the cost would be \$1166 per entity per year. Comm. Henderson moved to share the cost and

use the Alert Sense system, seconded by Comm. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion carried.

GAS QUOTES: The following quotes for gas were received: Dupree Oil LLC – E-10 Gas, \$3.16. Comm. Pesicka

moved to accept the quote from Dupree Oil LLC, seconded by Comm. Stocklin, all voted aye, motion carried.
