**MAY 6, 2022**

The Ziebach County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 AM with Clinton Farlee, Bill Henderson, David Pesicka, Rick Farlee and Ralph Lyon present. Chairman C. Farlee called the meeting to order.

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**MINUTES:** Comm. Lyon moved to approve the April 6<sup>th</sup> and April 12<sup>th</sup> minutes as presented, seconded by Comm. R. Farlee, all voted aye, motion carried.

**SHERIFF REPORTS:** Mike Deneui, Deputy Sheriff presented the monthly vehicle reports to the Board.

**FUEL QUOTES:** There were no firm fuel and gas quotes given for the month of May. Ziebach County will purchase gas from the lowest pump price and call for quotes when diesel is needed.

**SURFACE TRANSPORTATION FUNDS:** Ziebach County received \$235,728.06 from SDDOT for the Surface Transportation Program. These funds are to be used for road and bridge maintenance, repair and reconstruction.

**WATER PIPELINE EASEMENT:** Comm. Lyon moved to approve an Easement to Install Water Pipeline for Mni Waste, Eagle Butte, SD; seconded by Comm. Henderson, all voted aye, motion carried.

**APPROACH AND CULVERT EASEMENT:** Comm. R. Farlee moved to approve an Easement to Install Culvert and Approach for Lee Brooks, Dupree, SD; seconded by Comm. Henderson, all voted aye, motion carried.

**PROPERTY TAX REFUND:** Comm. Pesicka moved to approve a refund of property taxes in the amount of \$449.52 to Three B Farms, seconded by Comm. Lyon, all voted aye, motion carried. These taxes have already been paid.

**COURTHOUSE DOORS:** The front doors to the Courthouse are broken and need to be replaced. Ziebach County will call for estimates to replace the doors.
