

## MLU Requirements and Wait Times: Parent Copy

Symptom/Event	MLU Requirement	Lessons Hold Time
Fever over 100.5	NO	48 HOURS
Diarrhea/Vomiting	NO	48 HOURS
Medical Visit (nurse too)	YES	Pending Response from RET
Use of Rescue Inhaler (Albut. etc)	YES	Min. 24 HR wait. (New Respiratory Med is MINIMUM 72 HOUR wait)
Any Rash *must be diagnosed by child's doctor.	YES	Pending Response and/or Until dried or scabbed over
NEW Meds. (ANY, including over the counter meds and antibiotic)	YES	Pending RET response NOTE* antibiotics will require activity and temperature BUDS
Vaccines	NO	12 Hours (Unless child is age 4years-6years old and has had same vaccine previously, with no reaction)
A change has occurred to any of the student's major medical information found on the initial registration form (such as new specialist, significant injury, new diagnosis, etc.).	YES	Pending Response from RET
3 Consecutive Missed Lessons due to illness (*NOT VACATION)	YES	Pending Response from RET
Upon completion of a RET required Protocol (ie: their cast is removed, their stitches have been removed, etc)	YES	Pending Response from RET

**\*\*Additional reasons for no lesson\*\***

- Late arrival/missed your time slot (the timer begins with the clock at your lesson time)
- Lack of COMPLETED BUDS
- Lack of Non-disposable Swim Diaper and/or 3 towels
- Your child has ingested food or drinks within 2 hours of lesson (or dairy within 3 hours of the lesson, or apple products at all).
