Dear Mr. Layman:

On February 8, 2022, the East Hope City Council approved your request for the above-named property line adjustment of Mill Harbor Subdivision, with conditions.

The purpose of this letter is to provide a written decision required by Idaho Code and East Hope city codes. The decision letter includes the motion by the City Council, a reasoned statement, relevant criteria and standards, findings of fact (evidence), and the rationale for the decision, based on the applicable provisions of law and the file record.

MOTION: Council Member Wells moved, and Council Member Butler seconded the motion, to approve Property Line Adjustment File #PLA006-21, "A Replat of Mill Harbor," with conditions as written, finding that it is in accord with the City of East Hope's zoning codes and ordinances and the standards of Section 12-5. The motion further authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the final plat, upon confirmation by staff that the plat is in accord with the approved property line adjustment decision, city final plat requirements, requested corrections, and state platting requirements. The Mayor declared the motion approved on a unanimous voice vote.
