REFLECTING ON AUGUST: A MONTH OF CELEBRATION AND ACHIEVEMENTS

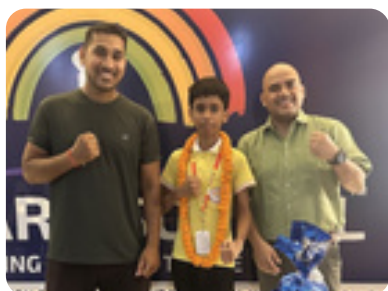
