Hudson Taylor, the 19th century missionary to inland China, gave three stages to the Lord's work. He said, "First it is impossible, then it is difficult and then it is done." In this letter you will see the impossible and difficult but by God's grace we will see things done. Hudson Taylor's motto was, "God is always advancing." While studying the events around this motto I discovered that the second part to this phrase used by Taylor was. "We will advance with God on our knees." The following is a list of things we are preparing. I am asking you to pray in order to help us advance the gospel to some needy areas in the state of New Mexico and Latin America.

We need to fill our calendar with meetings.

We are working hard to fill our calendar with meetings for the rest of this year and asking the Lord to meet the support needed. We are around 40% our goal. You can keep in contact at the cartefamily.com.

We need churches to help get the gospel to 33 million children in Mexico.

Christmas Gospel Joy Bags are a tool for small and new churches in difficult and restricted areas. A church planter will take a prepared Joy Bag and use it for a children's gospel crusade during Christmas time. We desire to strengthen churches in rural, needy and difficult areas in Mexico. We prepare the Joy Bags on the DLM property in Saltillo, Mexico and then distribute them to churches. This year we will increase to distributing 1,000 Joy Bags. We need to help strengthen the churches in Venezuela

Venezuela is a decimated country politically, financially and spiritually. We were church planting missionaries in Venezuela for 12 years. Many Venezuelans are still coming to faith in Christ. The Joy Bag effort last Christmas saw many saved and baptized. A few weeks ago, Pastor Miguel Rojas received the shipment of Bibles and Gospel Scriptures to be distributed. Please continue to pray for Precious Seed Baptist Church in Cua and their gospel work. Pastor Rojas lost a leg because of medical reasons during the socialistic takeover of Venezuela. He goes to dialysis three times a week and continues to be faithful to take God's word to the streets.

We need churches to continue to send construction teams to remodel the Distribution and Training Center in Saltillo, Mexico.

The next mission team will be from our sending church. We will be in Mexico at the end of July. We will prepare a classroom. This will include painting, minor repairs and flooring. We will also remodel one dorm area. This will include some demolition, painting, pluming and cleaning. These two rooms will add greatly to our use of the property for training and help other teams to be able to assist in distribution.
