SPRING MEETING INFO

Please be aware that these items are for you to look over and vote on at this meeting May 5th. There can be as much discussion as you like with any board member or at the next two board meetings on March 19th or April 16th. The board would like to hear your feedback on any of these topics. May 5th is a chance for you to vote on these items. There will not be time for opinions or soap box standing. We welcome your voice by your vote. Thank you.

Here are the topic up for vote:

Article 6. BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

1. Section 6.1. Board of Directors and Terms of Office

A. The Association shall be governed by a Board of Directors which shall consist of SEVEN members. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected for a two-year term. Members of the Board of Directors may be re-elected for a second two-year term, serving no more than four consecutive years as a voting member of the Board. [the only change is the word SEVEN which would replace the word NINE]

BE READY TO TALK ABOUT AND VOTE ON:

2. Vote for board members:

Tim Brain , President—open seat
Joe Sigona, Vice President—open seat
Jerry Stutzman, Treasurer—open seat
Tractor Chair—open seat
Safety Director—open seat

Kathleen Lawson, Secretary—remain in seat
Tom Trainor, Communications Director—remain in seat
Bob Kilbarger, Engine Chair— remain in seat
Fred Ferguson, Parliamentarian-remain in seat

3. This means that if the members vote for the change from 9 to 7 we would need to vote in 3 new board members. Please keep in mind Tim Brain and Joe Sigona have only filled in a two year term. If they choose to run again they can run for a two year term. Please think about running for the board. You can do a 2 year term or consider a 4 year term. Once your 4 years are up, the board asks that you take a rest for a least a year. Thank you again for your consideration to these items. Again, please come to a board meeting and voice your concerns. We have two opportunities to do so in March and April.

4. This is the other change needed for the by-laws to be change.

Article 10

The annual dues shall be due and payable each year on or before the first day of JANUARY. The amount charged as dues may be changed by a two-thirds vote of the General Membership at the Spring Business-Meeting. [The only change is the month, from the current by-law of June to the proposed change of January]. If this by-law passes than a half year of dues would be owed for June 2018 through December 2018 of \$12.50, this would be due and payable after June 1, 2018. On January 1, 2019 the full amount of the annual dues of \$25.00 would be due and payable, and good through December 2019.

BOARD of DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES

January 15, 2018

The January 15 th regular board meeting was called to order at 6:34 by President, Tim Brain.

The Invocation was given by Kathleen and Tim led the pledge of allegiance.

Roll Call: Present were: Tim Brain, Kathleen Lawson, Jerry Stutzman, Tom Trainor, Fred Ferguson, Bob Kilbarger, Joe Sigona and Ray From.

December Minutes Approval: The minutes were approved after a motion from Tom and a second from Fred.

Treasurer's Report: Jerry passed out a 2 page report and it was approved after a motion from Ray and a second from Fred. Jerry took some time to express concern from our dwindling bank accounts and other concerns. Kathleen suggested a committee be formed to assess the clubs spending and to look at the process of selling the commercial steel building that remains in storage. Jerry spoke of the need to increase awareness and attendance at our shows.

Farm Report: Dry up is the entire month of January for SRP to make necessary repairs and adjustments and so no water may be used. The alfalfa was cut and sold. Leon will pick up the check this week.

Saguaro Ranch Show: Tom says the fire damage continues to be a concern and the grounds are still a work in Progress. The dignitary parade from the Glendale City Hall to the show grounds is challenged with the farmers market that will going on and the Glendale Chocolate Affair that week-end as well. Volunteers are still needed.

AJ Show: Tim and Phil Frandsen will be taking care of the show permits, fire permit and the Pinal County Vendor Food licenses. Kathleen & Leon have passed on all the necessary information for all of that.

Old Business:

C-3 Transition – Tim is to meet next week with the previous board and the new board of Phil, Tracy Leake and Randy Waddle.

Club Liability Insurance: Joe is still trying to work out insurance for us being able to have non-members at the farm site for tours ie: school children, etc.

Fiesta Bowl Parade: Tim reported that 12 tractors, an engine float and Kenny Johnson's wagon made up our entry in the parade. The tv news coverage of our entry was the best that anyone could remember. A member in the audience asked why the wagon was displaying non-club banners and wondered about the liability it could create for that sponsor.

Expenses of the farm and profitability

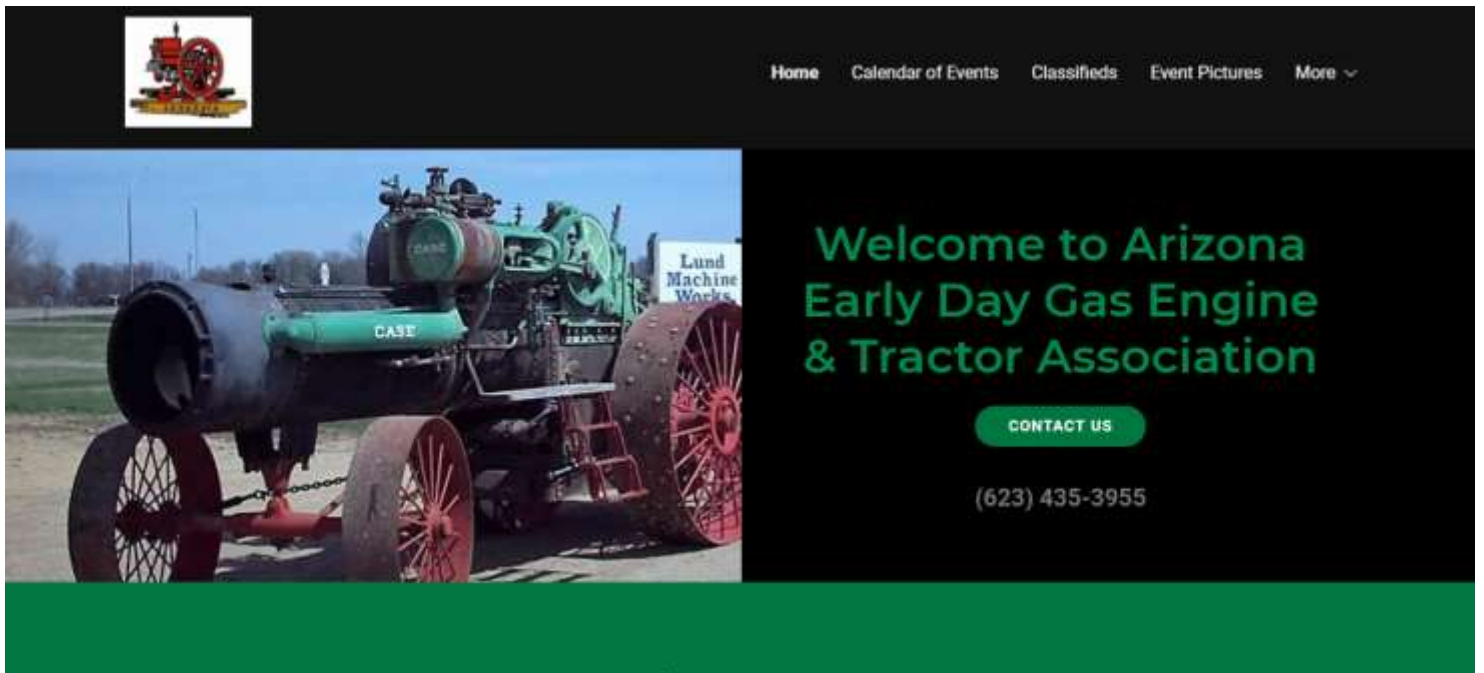
