



Gender-neutral toilet facilities can benefit transgender populations and people outside of the **gender** binary. Sex segregation in public toilets, as opposed to unisex toilets, is the separation of public toilets into male and female.

Rumors Cabaret has **gender-neutral** toilet facilities, Side Piece has a **unisex toilet**.

Unisex toilets are very easy- one person one room, anyone can use it.

Gender neutral toilet facilities can be a bit more challenging for Guests and Staff to understand and explain. Below is helpful information on how to talk with guests about toilet facilities.

Our Policy at Rumors Cabaret & Side Piece is anyone can use the toilet facility they feel most comfortable in. The entire building is a safe space for all who enter.

How to refer to restrooms (toilet facilities): We know that you will use your best discretion in explaining to Guest how you think they will best understand.

Restroom closest to the Bar (North Restroom): "Restroom also equipped with Urinals" or "Restroom with 2 urinals and an ADA stall"

Restroom closest to Boundary Bay (South Restroom):

"Restroom with all stall toilets" or "Restroom without urinals"

For some guests, it helps to say the words "Our Restrooms Are Not Gendered". If this statement still leaves someone confused, when safe to do so, please alert the manager so they can handle the guest further.

No Guest may be refused access to any restroom facility, nor discriminated against based on perceived gender. If you encounter discrimination or a guest tells you that they have been discriminated against, immediately assess security violations appropriately and follow up with the violator, Manager on Duty and the victim of discrimination.
