## 10 Important Questions to Ask

Before hiring a company, make sure you get clear answers to these questions:

- Can the company provide a D49 (formerly C49) Tree Service Contractor license number from the California State License Board (CSLB)?
- Can the company provide a City business license?
- o Can the company provide an up-to-date certificate of insurance?
- Does the company send an International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) certified arborist to your site to scope and monitor work?
- Does the company follow ANSI A300 Standards for tree pruning?
- Does the company avoid outdated, harmful practices like "topping" and "liontailing" trees?
- Can the company provide a list of references? Do they have a website or online reviews?
- Does the company follow safety protocols and wear Personal Protective Equipment (hard hats, chaps) required by OSHA?
- o Can the company provide a written scope, cost, and time estimates?
