The region of Transcarpathia, in the south-west corner of Ukraine and previously considered a safer haven, has now come under attack from Russian missiles and drones.

## Call for prayer



Since the monsoon season started in June, more than 700 people have died in flood-related incidents in Pakistan, hundreds of them in the past two weeks as landslides and flash floods have destroyed entire villages, with the worst damage in the province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Members of congregations belonging to the Methodist Church's partner Church, the Church of Pakistan are among those affected.

### Justice for a mother



I Fought the Law is the four-part ITV drama based on real-life bereaved mother Ann Ming and her campaign to change the double jeopardy law and ensure that her daughter Julie's murderer was convicted. Mark Braithwaite, a Methodist who features in the drama, was a junior police officer at the time of the 1989 murder and played a key role supporting the family throughout their ordeal and subsequent campaign.
