FOND MEMORIES OF DAYS GONE BY

As I remember days gone by, the first thing that comes to mind is the birth of my son in 1967 and the 39 years that I worked in the Shelby County School District. From 1967 to 2005, my main responsibilities included secretarial work at the local school level, and coordinator of Audio-Visual Media in the Department of Instruction. During the latter part of my career in Shelby County Schools, I became an accomplished recording R & B artist with my own record label—Bertland Records, Inc. I retired in 2005, and since that time have recorded five (5) CD's. Currently, I am recording a gospel CD.

As I reflect on these past years of achievements, fond memories of my earlier childhood days in the Arlington/Lakeland communities come to mind. For without these challenging experiences, my life may have taken a different turn. The property that my parents owned and inherited from my grandparents was adjacent to the Ellen Davies property. When I was about 6 years old, I can recall going to Brunswick Elementary School by way of cutting through the Ellen Davies Plantation. There seemed to be nothing but wilderness, cows, cotton fields, and the wood-framed houses in sight. I keenly remember one lady, Mrs. Lou Herring, who lived on the Plantation with her son in one of these wood-framed homes. She always wanted me to stay with her, and because of her love for me, my parents would allow me to stay with her from time to time. Whenever she saw me, no matter where, she would give me a quarter. This was her way to show just how much she cared.

Although fond in one way yet sad in another, I remember the day my routine route to school was unexpectedly interrupted by Mrs. Ellen Davies. After many years of farming and working for the Davies family, my parents had sacrificed and saved to a point that they were independent of continuing such chores. They had managed to amass sufficient assets of their own, including owning their own property. This did not please the Davies family; therefore, we (me and my siblings) were restricted from going through the Davies Plantation property to get to school.

As I grew into my adulthood, I began to see some changes in the neighboring community, Davies Plantation, and in roadway construction, which consisted of replacing graveled roads with asphalt. While some of the residents of the Plantation began to move out into affordable homes, others simply "died out" of the area. I can also recall seeing the growth of Stonebridge, the building of large beautiful brick homes in the "new Davies Plantation Residential area," the beginning of construction for the I-40 Expressway, and other incremental changes in the community—all in the name of "progress". History of the original Davies Plantation is still reflected in the ancient artifacts that remain on the property. The museum houses a wealth of history, and the buildings left standing on the grounds is evident of "years gone by". A tour of these grounds, artifacts, and buildings helped me to gain a better understanding of the struggles others encountered; yet were able to overcome trials, tribulations, poverty, and rise to another level. Although my family did not live on the Plantation, I am grateful for the connection my parents had with Mrs. Ellen Davies and her family.


