
There is also current news from the City of Bartlett and it's Major Departments (Police, Fire, Library, BPACC, etc.).

- Jessica Scott grew up in Davies Plantation along with her twin brother and two other brothers and one sister... Her family has lived in Davies since the 80's.On September 6th she will become Mrs. Nathaniel Haner and will be living in Fort Worth, Texas. Life was good to Jessica here in this beautiful community but now it is time to start her own little family. The theme for Jessica and Nate's wedding is "When Tennessee meets Texas"
  - From the **Ferraris Family** on Anderton Springs...One of the best kept secrets in our beautiful neighborhood was woman called "Mama". Her name is **Gracie Stephens** and she was a "hoot". She came into my life in 1995 and became my mother-in-law when Emil and I married in 1998. She was my husband's grandmother and she raised him and lived with him most of her life. She passed away July 14, 2015. She was 107. Back in the 90's we lived in the older part of Bartlett. She was known as "that older woman that drives a big ole Lincoln with a pitbull in the back seat". When Hurricane Elvis passed through in 2003 we had no power and Emil and I were trying to find the plug in the back of our new SUV to make coffee and by the time we figured it out Mama had made cowboy coffee on the charcoal grill.

When I first met her she had just gotten her ears pierced and she was 87 years old. On the weekends she would invite her friends over to play dominoes and they would keep us awake with their talking and laughing sometimes late into the night. She made us feel old!!!

When there was no food in the house, she would make a perfect meal. She was a "food pusher". You never left our house without eating something. It didn't matter if you were hungry or not, YOU ATE!! (sweet potato biscuits, coconut pie, and apple cake, and the list goes on.....)

Then there was the time we were out of town and her good friend Liz stayed with her. She couldn't wake up mama the next morning and Liz ran out of the house, flagged down a jogger and brought him in the house to wake her and when he did Liz said "Thank you, I thought she was dead!" They just laughed and laughed..... Poor guy, I never found out who he was.

I could have told how her life was living through the Depression, two World Wars, and being witness to many other events that most of us only hear about but instead I just wanted to re-live my memories one more time.




# Accomplishments!

One Davies resident went to Poland! Meet Josh McFall, a junior at Blue Mountain College in Mississippi, and lives on Peter Cove. In July he traveled to Poland on a short term mission trip under the auspices of INTERNATIONAL MESSENGERS. His team ministered at a family English camp in Krutyn, Poland, approximately 4 hours from Warsaw by bus. At the camp, he was a leader of 10 kids ages 4 to 7. Josh taught English to the kids by playing games, making crafts, and telling Bible stories from the book of John. During his free time in the afternoons he went hiking and kayaking.

Josh said the food at the camp was delicious and at least twice a day it included cucumbers and tomatoes. The evening activities were varied. One night there was a bonfire, which in Poland in July was

translator named Flippe, who attends the Baptist church in Gdansk, Poland, about how he came to have a personal relationship with Jesus. Unfortunately, our team did not have a lot of time to "tour" however, we did go to Wolf's Lair which were bunkers where a failed attempt was made on Hitler's life. Finally, before they left they had a chance to do some shopping. Josh knew what he wanted to get since he visited Po- land two years ago with his mom Barbara and sister Stephanie. Josh had a mission to bring back Polish chocolate bars and pottery! Even though he was there only 14 days, he formed close relationships with team members from the United States and Canada and of course the campers from Poland.
