The 2009 Yard of the Month program runs from April, through September. Monthly awards are given in three areas of competition

Volunteer judges will select winners in each category monthly.

Winners are ineligible to win again for two years. Judges consider the following when selecting the yards of the month:

- Curb appeal
- General condition of the lawn (cut, edged, weed free)
- Properly trimmed trees and shrubs
- Interesting colors of flower beds
- Condition of drives and sidewalks
- Side yard and backyard landscapes

There are no entry fees or applications and all homes in Davies Plantation are eligible. DPHA conducts this program as means of recognizing and encouraging well maintained landscapes in our neighborhood.

## New Canada Road

The planning phase for the New Canada Road is progressing on schedule. Building upon input from residents and land owners in the Lakeland area, the New Canada Road Advisory Team is focusing on the location and design of the roadway. A finalized plan should be ready for citizen review by the end of this year.

Concurrent with the efforts of the Advisory Team studies are underway to make certain that Federal and Tennessee regulations are followed. Impacts on residents such as social, noise and financial costs are part of the planning process. Impacts on natural environmental areas such as wildlife, historical sites, wet lands and forested areas are also considered. All plans for the New Canada Road must comply with these regulations. It normally takes 18 – 24 months for the studies to be completed following the final selection of the roadway plan.

Discussions are leaning toward a four land divided roadway including bike and walking paths, a wide median and appropriate landscaping. A workshop is scheduled for July 28 to gather public input on the proposed roadway.




