New Canada Road

The planning phase for the New Canada Road is progressing on schedule. Building upon input from residents and land owners in the Lakeland area, the New Canada Road Advisory Team is focusing on the location and design of the roadway. A finalized plan should be ready for citizen review by the end of this year.

Concurrent with the efforts of the Advisory Team studies are underway to make certain that Federal and Tennessee regulations are followed. Impacts on residents such as social,

noise and financial costs are part of the planning process. Impacts on natural environmental areas such as wildlife, historical sites, wet lands and forested areas are also considered. All plans for the New Canada Road must comply with these regulations. It normally takes 18 – 24 months for the studies to be completed following the final selection of the roadway plan.
