



**Paul and Jane Houghland** moved to Davies Plantation in 1998 and almost immediately became involved in our community. When you get to know them it is apparent that service to others is an important part of their lives.

After a hitch in the U S Army, Paul earned a BS degree from Oakland City College and a MS degree from Indiana University and then taught math/science in Seymour, Indiana. He and Jane have different allegiances in college sports since she attended the University of Missouri.

An active Jaycee, Paul served as President the Indiana Jaycees and Vice president of the U S Jaycees before moving to St Louis where he met Jane. Their service to others really took off there. Jane served as a volunteer at Children's Hospital and with the Soulard Restoration Group which Paul helped to organize. They were instrumental in the formation of Soulard Mardi Gras Association which has grown to be the second largest Mardi Gras event in the U S. and now brings about \$23 million into the St Louis economy annually. One of the highlights during the celebration is the selection of the Mardi Gras Queen and Jane had that honor.

When asked about his volunteer service, Paul said it has always been what he considers a responsibility facing everyone. His earliest memory of being a volunteer goes back to when he was in grade school. The March of Dimes was just that. People would donate coins and lay them on the sidewalk in front of stores on Main Street in the small hometown. Paul stood on the sidewalk asking for donations and keeping the coins in a straight line. Imagine doing that now.

Paul and Jane came to Bartlett from Washington, DC when Paul was hired to be the Executive Director of the National Hardwood Lumber Association. That was after serving as CEO of national and international professional and trade associations with headquarters in St Louis, Chicago and DC. During that period Jane was employed as the executive assistant to the president of an international engineering/architectural firm in St Louis and DC.

Since moving into Davies Plantation Paul has had one term as treasurer and three terms as president of the DPHA. Jane now serves as a DPHA Area Representative. Paul is currently the treasurer of the Davies Manor Association. Their service goes beyond our neighborhood. Jane is an officer of the Shelby County GOP Steering Committee and volunteers with the Memphis Sidewalk Councilors. Both are active with Bellevue Baptist Church and serve on the Board of Directors of Shepherds Haven. Both are active members of the N E Shelby GOP Club. Jane is currently employed by Bellevue Baptist Church and Paul is with the Family Action Council of Tennessee.




