New Canada Road Project Update

The Canada Road project from Highway 70 to Interstate-40 has been on the Shelby County Long Range Transportation Plan since 1980. The City of Lakeland and the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) have approved a contract to fund the project -- 80% by TDOT and 20% by the City of Lakeland. The goals of the project include; 1) increased capacity to improve safety and mobility. 2) provide an improved route to service projected increased traffic. 3) promote the potential for economic growth.

An advisory team of local residents and government officials met during 2009-2010 and after considering nineteen potential routes, agreed upon one route for the New Canada Road. Public input was invited and considered during the selection process. The route will consist of four lanes for traffic, a grassy median and bicycle/walking paths on each side of the roadway.

The second step in the total process is the conduct of studies required to meet standards set by the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). In the Fall of 2010 those studies were started and in the Spring of 2011 completed. The City of Lakeland will review the results of the study and must approve them for the project to move forward. There were no major deficiencies discovered in the NEPA study and Lakeland approval is expected.

Following the NEPA phase of the project an engineering design will be completed which will be followed by the necessary right-of-way acquisition. Completion of the New Canada Road is projected to be in 2015. That is, of course, if there are no major obstacles encountered in any of the remaining implementation phases. DPHA ANNUAL MEETING THURSDAY JUNE 23

Bartlett Mayor Keith McDonald and several city department directors will be present to address issues affecting our neighborhood and community at the Davies Plantation Homeowners Association annual meeting on Thursday June 23, 2011 at Hillwood. There will be refreshments starting at 6:30PM and the meeting will start at 7PM. Following the mayor's session there will be the election of 2011-2012 Davies Plantation Homeowners Association Board of Directors and the presentation of the annual report for 2011-2012. The main topics of local neighborhood interest for discussion include:

School Consolidation. Over-all status, options under review, and what we might be able to do to help.

Traffic/Street Issues. Neighbors seem generally pleased with the road re-paving that was done last Fall. However, a few neighbors want to see the streets re-stripped and a few don't. The over-all issue of re-stripping the streets has been reviewed by the DPHA Board and other neighbors. Based on all the input received, the main area of concern are a few of the sharp curves on Davies Manor and St. Phillip. We have asked that city engineering give some further consideration (depending on budget priorities) to re-stripping only those curves (not the whole street). Some neighbors also believe more could be done to eliminate speeding in the neighborhood, particularly on Davies Manor by stricter enforcement

Davies Park development. DPHA is continuing to work closely with Bartlett City Parks Department to develop the park. The walking trail has recently been completed and we have provided input from the neighborhood surveys to request additional park amenities as funding allows. We also have approximately \$10,000 in our current DPHA budget which could be allocated for park improvements when city funds are no longer available.

Any other topics you feel we need to discuss.

Your input on neighborhood issues is important and this will provide you with an opportunity to ask questions and express any concerns.


