

Neighbor Spotlight John Bookas

He was hired by Fed Ex in 1984 so that is when he first came

to Memphis. Originally he commuted from Charleston, SC, but he decided to move to the area in 1990. He started running during Desert Storm when he was activated with a friend who was an

avid runner. John said "I guess you say that is when my interest in the sport took off. Running was also the reason we moved to Davies Plantation in 2000. We always ran through this neighborhood when we lived in Stonebridge and looked at the houses for sale until we found the right one". He began volunteering due to his interest in running. He is currently the president of the Memphis Runners Track Club (MRTC) but has been on the board off and on since 2000. In addition to being president, he functions as a volunteer at many of the races as a member of the finish line crew and photographer. Last year Debi, his wife, and he were both coaches in the Women Run/ Walk Memphis program for the first time. It was a great experience and one he will do again. They hold a 10 week training program for women to go from the coach to a 5K. He was one of the coaches in the beginners group and he said "it was very rewarding to work with these ladies each week and see them improve with training". In addition to volunteering at MRTC events, he has two other major volunteer activities each year. He is the volunteer director for the St. Jude Memphis Marathon, Half Marathon and Grizzlies House 5K. They are in the 8th year of this event and raised over \$2 million for St. Jude last year. They need over 1,000 volunteers for this event and always appreciate that many in our neighborhood help out! Also Debi and he are the race directors for the UPS Ultimate 10K and 5K that takes place each year at the end of June in Davies Plantation. The proceeds of this event are donated to Youth Villages. They are in their 8th year as race directors and have raised over \$100,000 for Youth Vil-★ lages. Yes, there is never a dull moment! He says that the commraderie and volunteering spirit at all of these events is amazing! Memphis is a community that believes in giving back!!

Neighborhood Park Update

Progress on the development of the Davies Plantation Neighborhood park has been delayed primarily because of the weather. Playground equipment is scheduled to be installed and paving the parking lot completed by the 4th of July, so that the park will then be open for limited use. Starting in June, the lake will be drained and the fish relocated to repair the dam, which has been damaged by animal burrows. This will take about 2 months to complete. Afterwards, the lake will be refilled and restocked with fish. While the lake is drained, work on a land bridge on the east end of the pond will also begin in order to make the walking trail a complete loop around the lake perimeter.

Our goal is to develop a neighborhood park that will strive to preserve and enhance the natural character of the neighborhood while providing basic neighborhood park amenities for Davies Plantation neighborhood families to use and enjoy. If you have questions or want to provide additional input on the park design, David Thompson, Bartlett Parks Director will also be at the DPHA Annual Meeting on June 10 at Hillwood along with Mayor Keith McDonald to discuss more details and answer questions.

New Canada Road Update

Several of our neighbors have inquired as to the status of what will be the New Canada Road. And exactly where the new road will be.

The realignment of Canada Road from I 40 to Hwy 70 is a joint project of the City of Lakeland, Shelby County and the State of Tennessee with 80% of funding to come Tennessee and 20% from Lakeland. In September of 2009 a 15 member advisory committee composed of neighborhood residents and City of Lakeland officials was appointed to study alternate routes and designs and to make recommendations for final approval. That committee has completed its assignment and the final plan submitted to the Lakeland Board of Aldermen..

The New Canada Road will be a four lane divided highway with bike/walkways on each side. The road will follow the path of existing Canada Road from I 40 north to Windward Slopes and then turn northwest through what is mostly undeveloped land connecting with the existing designated right of way at William Little Road. The route will continue on that right of way through the Plantation Hills and Woodbridge neighborhoods, turning northeast to join the existing Canada Road just south of I. H. Park and continuing north to the current intersection of Canada Road and Hwy 70.

Although the funds for the road have been approved, due to the current economic downturn the allocation will be made in increments. The plan calls for the following phases.

> Spring 2010 -- Environmental Assessment Completed Spring 2011-- Preliminary Engineering Completed

2012-- Right of Way Acquisition

2013- Utilities Relocated

2014-- Construction of New Canada Road

The end product will provide an improved route to serve traffic between I 40 and Hwy 70, improve safety and mobility, increase capacity to accommodate increased traffic demands and be environmentally friendly.
