

NISE Re-Opening Plan

All clients must adhere to the following guidelines...

- All clients must wear a face covering while in common/high traffic areas of the facility where 6 foot social distancing cannot be met. This includes upon entrance and exit of the facility, when walking through the facility, when in Precision Bicycles, etc...
- Please remain home if you are feeling sick, have a fever, have been in contact with someone that tested positive with COVID-19, or traveled to an area that has a high rate of positive COVID-19 cases.
- All clients must remain 6 feet from each other whenever possible.
- Face coverings do not have to be worn in the cages or on the gyms, so long as 6 feet of distance can be met. If two people in the gym or in a cage cannot be 6 feet apart then both parties must wear a face covering.
- We will not accept walk-ins at this time. All clients must book their reservations ahead of time with Neal Turvey II directly (716-462-8155).
- Parents, siblings, and friends should refrain from coming to the facility as a spectator. When this is not possible, face coverings must be worn by those individuals where 6 foot social distancing cannot be met.



- All tables and chairs have been removed from the facility to ensure proper social distancing and reduce cross contamination.
- All clients must remain 6 feet from one another when in Precision Bicycles.
- NISE will offer disposable gloves which can be used to pick up the balls in the cages.
- NISE employees will sanitize the facility and common areas daily, including at the start and end of each shift, and every 2 hours while on shift.
- There are hand sanitizing stations throughout the facility that we encourage everyone to use as frequently as possible.
- Equipment that NISE provides such as basketballs, volleyballs, batting tees, etc. for their clients will be loaned out for individual use **ONLY** and will be sanitized after every use. Players will need to bring their personal equipment (ex: bats, batting helmets, gloves) and not share with teammates during practices.
- NISE discourages hand to hand contact such as handshakes, high-fives, and fist bumps.



- All clients should avoid congregating in groups.
- The public water jugs will not be accessible at this time. Please be sure to bring enough water with you or you may purchase bottles of water at the front desk.
- Only one baseball or softball mound will be utilized at a time.
- Instructors can begin giving lessons and must adhere to all the above rules, including the following.
 1. Instructors and their players must wear a face covering if they are less than 6 feet apart.
 2. Parents and siblings must remain outside to reduce the number of people in the facility at one time.

 4. Instructors will maintain accurate records of their students' lesson details (name, date, & time). This information will be kept in order to adhere with the NYS tracing rules.



- Teams may begin practicing and must adhere to all the above rules, including the following:

1. Gymnasium Reservations:

- a. Players must remain in the gym area and adhere to social distancing guidelines while waiting for their turn.
- b. Coaches must wear a face covering when 6 foot social distancing cannot be met.
- c. Coaches must provide NISE Staff with the names of the players that will be attending practice that day at the time the reservation is made. This information will be kept in order to adhere to NYS tracing rules.
- d. Teams should come to the facility just a few minutes prior to the start of their reservation and leave immediately afterwards. The team's Head Coach should enter the facility prior to any players entering to ensure that the gym is clear from any previous reservations.
- e. Teams should refrain from congregating and should adhere to social distancing guidelines while in the facility.



2. Cage Reservations:

- a. Reservations are limited to one team in the facility at any one time.
 - b. Players must adhere to social distancing while waiting for their turn in the cage.
 - c. Coaches must wear a face covering when 6 foot social distancing cannot be met.
 - d. Coaches must inform the NISE Staff of the names of the players that have shown up to practice. This information will be kept in order to adhere to NYS tracing rules.
 - e. Teams should come to the facility just a few minutes prior to the start of their reservation and leave immediately afterwards and should refrain from congregating.
 - f. Team reservations will only be scheduled directly through Neal Turvey II (716-462-8155) via phone call.
- All clients are requested to follow these guidelines, or they may be asked to leave the facility.
