The Cloud-Nine Motel held it's open house on Sunday, March 3, 1963. At the time of the open house, the motel had been open to the public for several weeks.

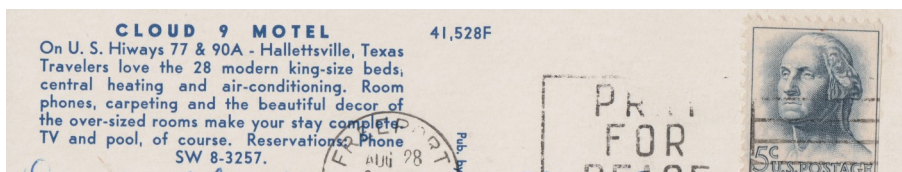
