49th Annual Stan Sutor Masters 2023

The Masters Tournament Format will remain unchanged this season. The first matches (Feb. 4th) of the tournament will be SINGLE ELIMINATION matches, quickly taking 32 bowlers down to 16. These 16 winners will then begin double eliminations. The idea is to shorten the length of time needed to commit, resulting in a greater number of bowlers participating. As in years past, we'll hold a "Bowler Calcutta" auction on Friday night, February 3rd in the main bar of the Club beginning at 7:00 PM SHARP.

Championship matches, will take place on Saturday, February 25th. Watch your Turner Blast for the details. The championship match will be formatted as a 4 BOWLER LADDER ROLL OFF: 2 game matches, beginning with 4th place vs. third. The winner of that match then takes on the 2" place finalist, and the winner of that match will then try to beat the one undefeated contestant (twice).

The final matches should roll along at a fast and furious pace, with the 4 Bowlers competing for the Masters Champion title. After this has been determined, pictures will be taken, awards will be presented and following that, think CELEBRATION!

The journey begins with the 12th annual Arlene Sutor Qualifying Tournament which begins the week of January 9th is open to all bowlers with an established average whether they can manage the Masters or not. A first place prize will be awarded for the high qualifier.. As before, qualifying takes place during regular league bowling. A "Last Chance" qualifying round will be held on SUNDAY, January 29th at 12:00 Noon for any non-league bowlers or league bowlers who want to give it one last chance to better their qualifying position. League Qualifying costs are \$10.00 for the 1st qualifying attempt and \$5.00 for subsequent attempts. Fee for Non-League bowlers qualifying in the Last Chance round will be \$10.00.

RULES:							
All ABC rules to be in effect.							
*Tournament is open to any member in good standing (meaning your 2022 dues must be paid before you qualify)							
This is a non-sanctioned handicap tournament. Handicap will be based on 90% of 210. Handicap will be determined by utilizing each bowler's previous year's ending league average unless this year's average as of December 31st, is 10 pins or more higher than last year's average. If this year's average is 10 pins or higher than last year, we will use this year's average. Average is based on at least 21 games played before date of entry. You must have an established average to bowl.							
Qualifying will take place from the 9 th to January 29 th during regular league games and Sunday, January 29 th at Noon. Initial fee for qualifying during your regular league bowling will be \$10.00. Re-entry fee is \$5.00 for all. The fee must accompany the entry form. Enter as many times as you wish. Each re-entry cancels the previous score. Maximum handicap will be 75 pins. A Prize will be awarded to the high qualifier.
