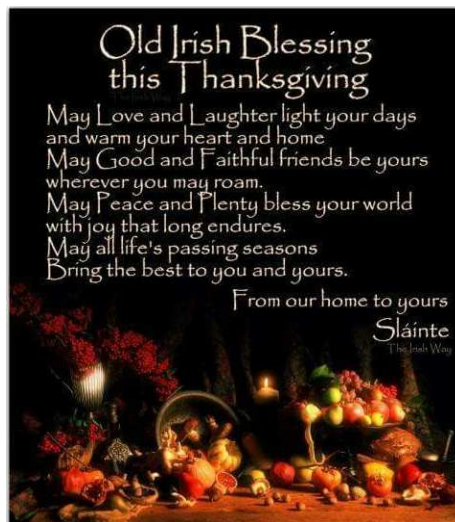
NOVEMBER IS NOMINATION MONTH!

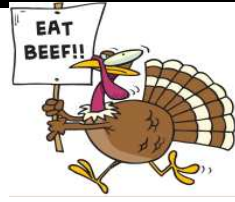
