You'll be traveling on the Kansas Turnpike, a toll road between Kansas City International Airport and Topeka. Since the turnpike operates with a cashless toll system, be sure to check with your rental car company about their toll fee policies.

The drive from the airport to downtown St. Marys takes approximately an hour and a half.

Good Eats: Downtown St. Marys offers a variety of dining spots, each with its own charm and flavor. For a quick and delicious lunch, [Sugar Creek Country Store](#) serves up hearty soups and fresh sandwiches in a nostalgic, old-fashioned setting—perfect for a step back in time.

If you're looking for a lively evening out, [Pilgrim's Keep](#) is a must-visit. This cozy pub, open for lunch and dinner, offers classic pub fare, live music, and an unbeatable ambiance. On Fridays, they serve seafood, and their steak tips appetizer is a local favorite! Keep in mind, both Sugar Creek and Pilgrim's Keep are closed on Sundays.

For classic comfort food with serious small-town character, [Benedict Bar & Grill](#) has quickly become a local favorite. Known for its BBQ, burnt ends, fried hot dogs, and beef-tallow-fried french fries, it's the kind of place that feels unapologetically Midwestern in the best possible way. They proudly cook with tallow instead of seed oils — a rarity these days — and the difference absolutely shows. Closed on Sundays.

If you're craving Mexican flavors, [El Corral](#) serves up all the favorites but is closed on Mondays. [MJ's Coffeehouse](#) is the perfect spot for a morning pick-me-up, offering coffee and breakfast every day of the week. If sushi is more your style, [Firefly Sushi](#), located near downtown, delivers fresh and flavorful options but has limited hours, closing early and remaining closed on Sundays.
