

Elementary Summer Program at Monroe Montessori School

The Elementary Summer program offer opportunities for children going into 2nd through 5th grade to work together on academics within classroom and outdoor environments. Students will complete classroom works and weekly themed hands-on projects in addition to recreational fun, nature walks, and school bus trips to a variety of meaningful destinations. This program runs from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. daily.

Classroom works center around the theme of the week and involve reading, writing, and math skills as well as creative thinking and problem solving skills. Outdoor time includes additional hands-on activities, arts-n-crafts, recreation, water play and off-campus adventures (see flyer). Students return to the classroom by 3:00 p.m. for a review of the day before getting ready to dismiss at 3:30 from the elementary building. Before and after school care is available in from 7:00-8:30 a.m. and 3:30 - 6:00 p.m. in classroom A3 (former school office).

Summer Slide - It is important to keep your child’s brain active and learning during the summer months. Not using or challenging your brain for 3 months has unintended consequences in young children. It is referred to as “summer academic loss” or “summer slide” and it’s real! Studies have shown that children enrolled in summer programs are 2 years ahead of their peers by the time they reach fifth grade. It’s easy to see the importance of continuing to develop critical thinking skills, academic confidence and cognitive ability throughout the summer. *Stop Summer Academic Loss. 3 July 8 - July 12	Science: This week we will explore how everyday items interact. We will explore gravity, create art with science and do some ooey gooey chemistry experiments. We will learn about the scientific process through a variety of hands on experiments.	<input type="checkbox"/> \$295	
4 July 15- July 19	Creative Writing: We will explore the world of writing and literature! Each day we will focus on a specific literary style. 5 July 22 - July 26	Create a Community Garden: This week we will be partnering with mentors from the Monroe Gardening Club to create a school garden. We will plant a garden in the backyard behind the school office. Children at Monroe Montessori will be able to maintain this garden throughout the school year. We will learn about different types of soil, seed germination, pollinating flowers, vertical gardening and starting a compost bin. We will take a walking field trip to the Monroe Community Garden where we will learn how to work together to develop a new garden space. 6 July 29- Aug. 2	Habitat Build and Environmental Studies: We will be creating our own small habitats with materials gathered throughout the week outside. During the week we will be going on nature walks and exploring different habitats and their importance to our environment. 7 Aug. 5 - Aug. 9	Fun with Geology: This week we will be exploring the process of Earth's rock formations (sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic). Through hands on activities, we will explore the layers of ground beneath us and participate in nature walks to see different rock formations. 8 Aug. 12- Aug. 16	Healthy Bodies-Healthy Minds: This week students will learn how to care for their bodies and minds in a healthy, positive way. We will learn how to cool down our bodies using the art of yoga. We will learn a variety of breathing techniques and how to target different muscles in our body. We will also learn about nutrition and healthy eating by preparing healthy snacks.
