

Elementary Summer Program at Monroe Montessori School

The Elementary Summer program offer opportunities for children going into 2nd through 5th grade to work together on academics within classroom and outdoor environments. Students will complete classroom works and weekly themed hands-on projects in addition to recreational fun, nature walks, and school bus trips to a variety of meaningful destinations. This program runs from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. daily.

Classroom works center around the theme of the week and involve reading, writing, and math skills as well as creative thinking and problem solving skills. Outdoor time includes additional hands-on activities, arts-n-crafts, recreation, water play and off-campus adventures (see flyer). Students return to the classroom by 3:00 p.m. for a review of the day before getting ready to dismiss at 3:30 from the elementary building. Before and after school care is available in from 7:00-8:30 a.m. and 3:30 - 6:00 p.m. in classroom A3.
