



The Colorado Titans Basketball Club invites your daughter to participate in our tryouts on the following dates for each respective age group:

March 1st and March 15th – U14 – U17; (8th Grade, 9th Grade, 10th Grade 11th grade/ Unsigned Seniors)
(We strongly encourage their participation in both tryout sessions)

For the 2020 season the Colorado Titans Basketball Club intends to field the following:

U17/U16 – Class of 2021-2022: One Team

U16 –U15 Class of 2023-2024: One Team

U14 – Class of 2024: Three Teams

Tryout Dates: Times are posted on our website - www.coloradotitans.com. The last 15 minutes of the final tryout sessions will include an important parent organizational meeting to discuss the selection of the teams.

We are a 501(c) 3, tax-exempt, non-profit Colorado Corporation (Tax ID #23-4364084). Our mission is to provide 12-18 year olds the opportunity to learn the game of basketball and grow and mature as people and players throughout this experience. Our season begins with tryouts in March and peaks in late July as we wrap up our season playing in a national tournament in Las Vegas, Nevada.

We, the Colorado Titans, commit to develop players through hard work, practice, and inspired coaching. Our teams practice 2-3 times per week beginning in early April at local area schools and recreational centers. We schedule most teams to play between 35 and 50 games during our season. Titans' coaches emphasize individual skill development, teach team concepts, and require all players to give 100% effort and to compete at the highest level.

Costs:

U14 – U17 - \$1900 to \$3600

These numbers are estimates based on current club/team projections, number of out of state tournaments, and are subject to change after the teams are selected. Team options that impact costs are discussed with families at the mandatory team meeting following the week of tryouts.

Donations: As a 501(c) 3, tax-exempt, non-profit Colorado corporation we are constantly reaching out to our community leaders and businesses seeking donations. We also have a donation letter that players may take into the community (family, friends, and local business) and request financial contributions to offset some of the costs of our program. These donations could be classified as a tax-deductible contribution to our 501(c) 3 non-profit corporation.

Scholarships: Players may also apply for scholarship assistance to offset a portion of the costs of our basketball programs. The Board of Directors sets the amount allocated for individual scholarships after review of your application and relevant financial documents including past years' tax returns.
