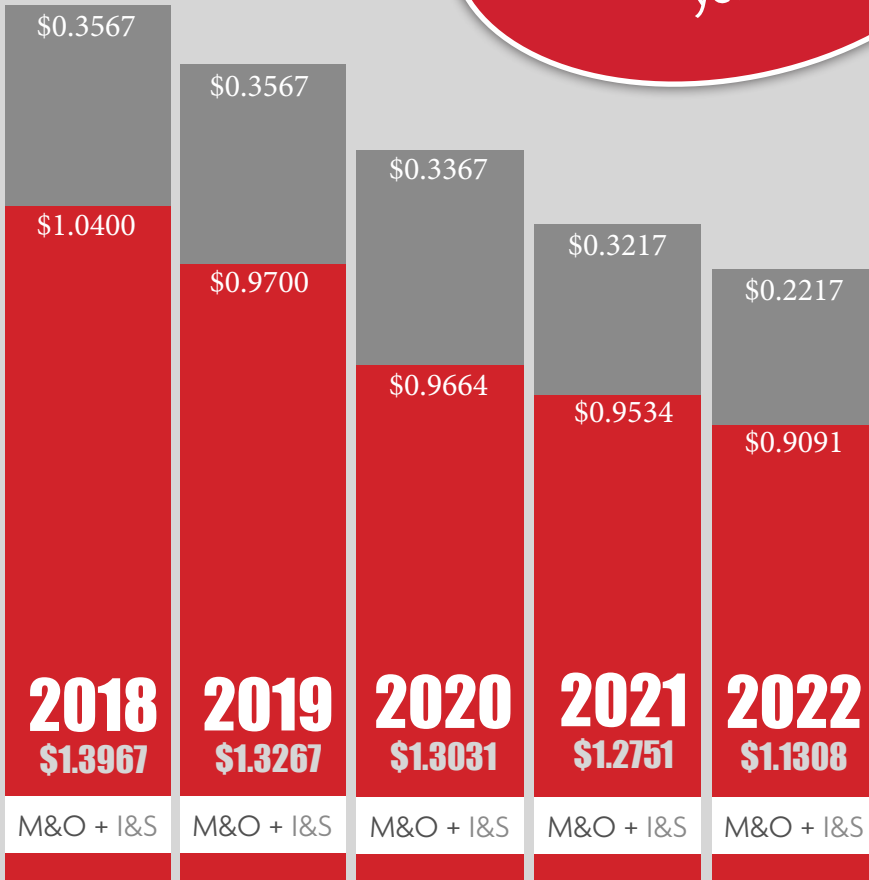


GCISD Tax Rate Lowered

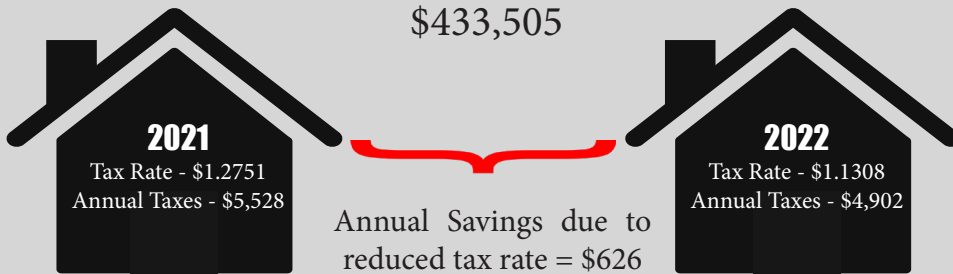
The GCISD total tax rate has been reduced 26.59 cents in the last four years.

- M&O (Maintenance & Operations)
Pays for daily operations of the district.
- I&S (Interest & Sinking)
Pays for voter approved bonds.



2022 GCISD Average Home Value

\$433,505



Local homestead exemptions are available which reduce the 2022 taxable home values by \$40,000. This is an increase of \$15,000 from previous years.

GCISD's Past & Projected Robin Hood Payments

Over the past five years, the District has sent over \$260 Million of M&O tax collections to the State through the Robin Hood payment.

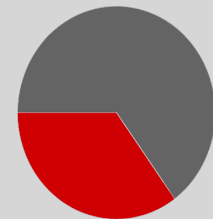

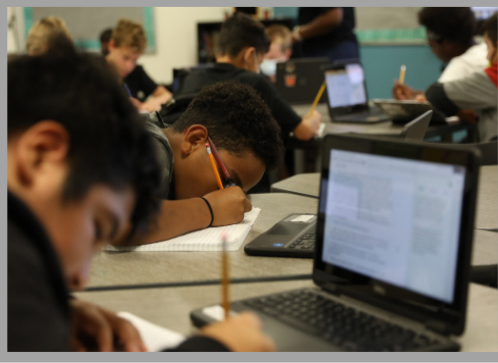


Approximately 35% of M&O tax collections will be sent to the state.

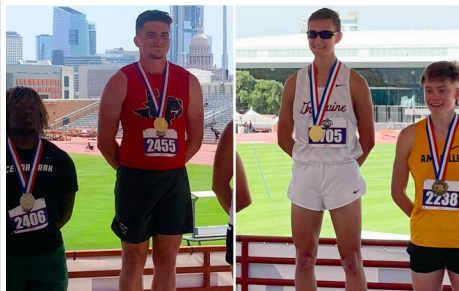
