
# **GCISD Tax Rate Lowered**

- M&O (Maintenance & Operations)
  Pays for daily operations of the district.
- I&S (Interest & Sinking)
  Pays for voter approved bonds.

The GCISD total tax rate has been **reduced**26.59 cents in the last four years.

Local homestead exemptions are available which reduce the 2022 taxable home values by \$40,000. This is an increase of \$15,000 from previous years.
