
Prophet Moses Admonishes to Hear, Remember, Obey



This Shema Prayer is recited by Israelites twice a day in the evening and again in the morning as a reminder of God.

DEUTERONOMY 6-8, 15, 18, 29-30, & 34

The last 3 sermons of the five Books of Moses, Deuteronomy contains the final "Words" of Moses to Israel before Joshua becomes their new leader of the new generation.

The book of Deuteronomy is the last scroll in the Torah also called the Pentateuch or the 5 books of Moses. Deuteronomy comes from Greek which means "Second Law" or "Recitation of the Law". In Hebrew, it is called HaDevarim הדברים

meaning "The Words", which is the first word that appears on the scroll.

After delivering Israel from Egypt and leading them for 40 years in the desert, these are the final words of Moses to the next generation of Israel. Moses' final sermons are in 3 parts: First, a History lesson with a warning to Remember the miracles of God (Deut 1-4). Second, teachings on the Laws with a plea to Obey (Deut 5-26). Third, Prophecy of the Messiah and the issuing of the new Covenant with the new generation of Israel (Deut 27-34). Finally, Joshua, the Ephraimite, is ordained by Moses to succeed him and lead Israel into the Land of Promise. AR
