

CO-CREATION; Our Divine Responsibility

Workshop with Rev. Thomas Janssen

“While we eat a breakfast we may or may not like we are ordering lunch. While we eat a lunch we may or may not like we are ordering supper. While we eat a supper we may or may not like we are ordering breakfast. It is not the cook or the server that needs change.” Rev. Thomas

We are Spiritual Beings (made in God/Creator's likeness and image) having this Human Experience. Our creative ability is in our DNA, it is an essential and unchangeable part of our being. We cannot stop it, only use it consciously with purpose. How do I learn to do this? You were born doing it! We co-create (contribute) to what we experience next.

We must move from denial, “what happened?” to acceptance, “I did this!” Without taking ownership we remain victims (helpless). Ownership provides both responsibility (*ability-to-respond*) and means to change (spiritual growth/do better next time). The Aramaic word for “sin” meant when an arrow missed the intended target. *Sin* is not about condemnation or punishment, rather we are meant to learn from our errors and to grow from each experience.

In this workshop we will explore this idea as a concept and as a real life practice. We will explore it from the macro (global) and the micro (personal) affect we have on *reality* or perhaps better said, our *experience of reality*. This will be an interactive discussion as we consider these ideas from our own experience and from channeled sources.
