Notice of Funds Availability (NOFA) for Emergency Solutions Grants Program (ESGP)

9 June 2026—The Louisiana Housing Corporation (LHC) has released the Notice of Funds Availability (“NOFA”) for Emergency Solutions Grants Program.

ESG funds may be used to assist homeless persons and those at risk of becoming homeless. The Emergency Solutions Grant includes the eligible activities of the Emergency Shelter Grant, to which the eligible activities of the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-housing activities have been added.

Through establishing regional allocation pools, in conjunction with a competitive grant award process, funds will be distributed to State recipients to carry out the purposes of the ESG Program. In anticipation of these federal funds, the LHC is inviting cities, parish’s local municipalities, Continuum of Care, and non-profit agencies to review this Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA).

Organizations interested in applying for 2025 ESG funds awarded to the State must read and carefully analyze all NOFA and grant requirements before applying. The LHC also expects applicants to be fully informed of all regulations applicable to ESG, and if funded, to comply with all applicable regulations. In particular, before applying, applicants must be familiar with and knowledgeable of the following regulations and program requirements
