

Omaha Housing Market Stats for October 2024 (compared to the previous month)

- Change in <u>Closed Sales</u> ALL PROPERTIES: -1.0% from September
- Change in the Median Closed Price ALL PROPERTIES: +6.8%
- Change in Homes for Sale ALL PROPERTIES: +21.9%
- New Listings increased 2.0% for New Construction and 11.0% for Existing Homes.
- Pending Sales increased 29.1% for New Construction and 3.9% for Existing Homes.
- <u>Inventory</u> increased 11.9% for New Construction and 30.5 % for Existing Homes.
- Median Closed Price decreased 1.9% for New Construction but increased 7.3% for Existing Homes.
- Days on the Market increased 68.2% for New Construction and 60.0% for Existing Homes.

According to the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) as of October 2024:

- U.S. existing-home sales unexpectedly slipped 1.0% month-over-month and 3.5% year-over-year to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 3.84 million, the lowest level in more than a decade.
- Prospective buyers have pulled back in recent months, despite lower mortgage rates and more home choices compared to the same time last year.
- There were 1.35 million units for sale heading into September, a 0.7% increase from the previous month and a 22.7% jump from the same time last year.
- There were 1.39 million homes for sale heading into October, a 1.5% increase from the previous month and a 23% increase from the same period last year, for a 4.3-month supply at the current sales pace.
- Even with improving supply and the slower sales pace, home prices have continued to rise nationwide, with a median existing-home price of \$404,500 as of last measure, a 3% increase from one year ago.

NOTE: This report covers residential real estate activity in the Omaha area, which includes the counties of Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders and Washington in Nebraska; the counties of Harrison, Mills and Pottawattamie in Iowa; and the following ZIP codes: 68016, 68037, 68048, 68307, 68403, 68403, 68403, 68455 and 68463. % changes are calculated using rounded figures.
