

The Liam and Reece Kelly Memorial Scholarship Application



In honor of Liam and Reece Kelly who were tragically killed in a plane crash on September 20th, 2020, this annual scholarship in cooperation with the Liam and Reece Kelly Foundation will provide a scholarship for XC athletes at WHS.

Liam was a senior and Reece was a sophomore. Both had goals to attend the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, CO to pursue aeronautical engineering and ultimately become commercial pilots.

Liam & Reece loved their teammates and this scholarship will be a legacy that will provide support in a way that would bring honor to them both for years to come.

The amount of the scholarship & the number of scholarships awarded will be determined annually by the Kelly Family.

Qualifications: WHS senior that has participated in XC for all 4 yrs. Special preference for JV athletes. Candidates with a GPA of 3.5 or higher will be preferred although 3-3.5 GPA will also be considered. Athletes must have an acceptance letter to an accredited university or college of his/her choice with intent to start classes the following fall semester.

- WHS XC & Track participation-please list years involved and any awards
- Academic achievements-please list academic honors and/or awards. You may include all athletic participation prior to HS.

- Employment history
- Personal essay-describe your educational & career goals, community involvement and any volunteer work. Essays should be limited to 2 pages.
- 2 letters of recommendation- One from a coach and the other from a mentor. This mentor can be from the school, church, work or volunteering but should be someone that has been present in your life for more than 2 yrs.

All applications should be received by April 1st of your senior year.
