WAIT!!



We hate to wait. It means we have to slow down, or maybe even stop. It means that we can't get to or do whatever it is that is our goal as soon as we would like. Waiting can be uncomfortable – just ask any woman who has given birth when she is about a week out from

her due date! Waiting can be joyful – just ask any grandparents-to-be as they anticipate the birth of their first (or successive) grandchild, and as they watch their child become a parent. Waiting can be boring – just ask any child or teen who has to cool their heels – without phone, table, or other device to keep them occupied!

Advent is a time of waiting. We are counting down the 4 Sundays before Christmas Day, anticipating the birth of Jesus. We are also anticipating the time when Jesus will come again. Some of the waiting is boring, some is joyful, some is uncomfortable.

I would invite us to wait together, as a community, checking in with each other each Sunday at worship, and see how the waiting is going as the time gets closer.

A New Year Bible Challenge

I have a challenge for you. Do you think you can read the entire Bible in the next year? I know that often New Years' Resolutions (New Years' Challenges?) begin on January 1, and generally peter out by the time Lent begins in February. So, an idea is to start reading scripture daily beginning November 30, the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of the liturgical year,

It can be hard to figure out how to manage this. Do you start from Genesis and read all the way through Revelation? (I would not necessarily recommend this. Genesis and Exodus are fine, but many people quit when they hit Leviticus or Numbers.) How many chapters a day should you read? (This depends on how you want to approach this.) What happens if you miss a day? (You could either read double the next day, or spread out the catching-up over a week, adjusting the reading schedule.)

There are many calendars out there that say they will guide you through reading the Bible in a year. Some Bibles even have such a chart/calendar included! There is no one-size-fits-all! It all depends on your schedule, how you want to read (chronologically, in book order, the order in which they were written) etc.

I have looked online and found several sources to check out. This is not an exhaustive list!

This resource has multiple options for version/translation to use, and you can choose how you want to read (Old Testament then New Testament, order written, order in history, combination, etc).

https://www.biblica.com/resources/reading-plans/

This resource has Old Testament, New Testament, and Psalm/Proverbs reading for each day. You can choose the date you want to begin.

This is a blog post, and the nice thing about this listing is it has you reading 5 days a week, so if you have to miss a day, or want to take a day off, you aren't behind. It has a pdf that you can print off, to keep track of your reading.

This is an online resource, so you don't need to print anything out. It has several plans/options to check out.


