Summer is here! The grass and trees are vibrant green. Ball games and s'mores abound. The swimming pool is full, and many families spend their weekends on the road – some to “the lake” and some camping in various locations, some travel to various sporting events, or to drop off/pick up children from different camps. It is good to get away, but it is also good to stay connected. When you are away, please tune in to First Lutheran to see what is going on at church! Read the Voice when it comes to your email (this is a June/July issue, so be on the lookout for August's edition!), and see what's happening with my weekly Friday Flash. And, if you are in town, we'd love to see you in person!



But leaves and grass aren't the only green things visible in the summertime. If you look at the paraments (the cloth across the front of the altar, and on the front of both the pulpit and the lectern), you will see that it is green from June 22 to November 16, with a couple of exceptions (red for Reformation and white for All Saints Sunday). In the springtime, we look forward to seeing the grass green up, the buds pop on the trees, and the tender sprigs of corn plants and puff balls of bean plants in their neat rows in the fields. Green in the spring and early summer is a sign of growth.

Growth happens during the “green season” of the church year, too. The six months of the church year from December to May has all sorts of color – blue in December for Advent, white from late December to mid-January for Christmas, green in January, February and sometimes in March for Epiphany, purple in February (sometimes), March and April for Lent, and white in April and May for Easter. This half of the year includes the major festivals of Christianity, Christmas and Easter, as well as the seasons leading

up to them, and coming after them. This half of the year is more about the birth and death of Christ, with some of his teachings sprinkled in.

The second half of the year, though, stays green. We hear Jesus's teaching in this half of the year. We overhear what he says to the disciples. We see the miracles he does – healings, feeding people, and others. We see how he spars with the religious leaders, who try to trip him up and trap him (but it doesn't work). This is a time for us to travel with Jesus, as his disciples did, to soak up all we can from him, so that we can put what he is teaching to work in our lives. This is the ordinary meat and potatoes of faith, food that sustains and nourishes.

I invite you to participate in church as you can over the summer, in person if possible, but online, on tv, or on the radio if you can't be here on a Sunday morning. Keep learning, listening for new ideas, thoughts to challenge you and build up your faith.

Remember, there are things happening outside of Sunday morning worship at church, too! We will probably have a unit in the Water Tower Festival parade. There is talk of campfire and s'mores event. There may be a group gathering to attend an A's game. We may have a Sunday worship service outdoors. The Fair Stand will need people to work (the fair is July 30-August 2). If there is something you want to do with folks from church, let us know, and we will see if we can plan it!

Also, remember to keep your eyes peeled for God. If you need a postcard, you can get one (or more) at church. We will be collecting the cards in September. It will be lots of fun to see where all everyone saw God this summer! It can be something in nature, an interaction between people, something that happens to you or a family member, wherever and however you see God! You can write or draw, and this is open to people of all ages. God is on the loose!

- 2) To the right (>) is a Quick Response (QR) code. When you scan the QR code image with a smartphone's QR decoder, it will instantly connect you to the mobile version of the church's Vanco/Simply Giving offering site. Just follow the directions on your screen.
- 3) Be watching for other options as they become available.
- 4) Good ol' offering envelopes - they are tried and true still today!!

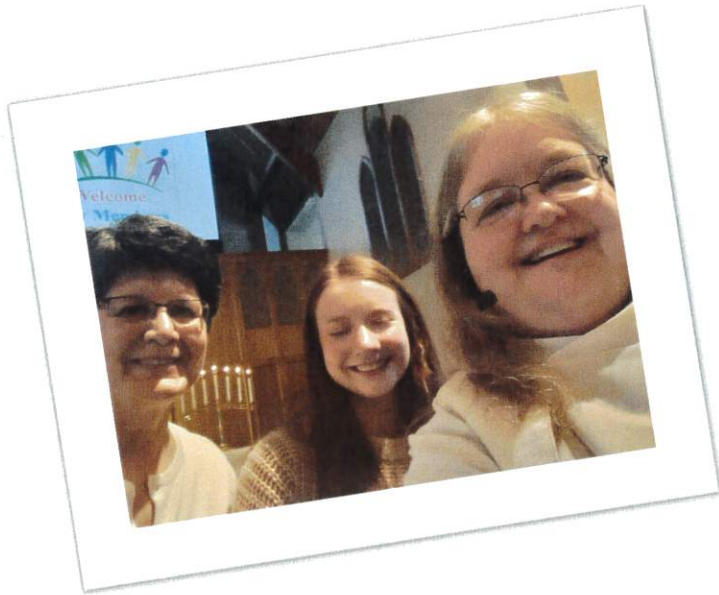

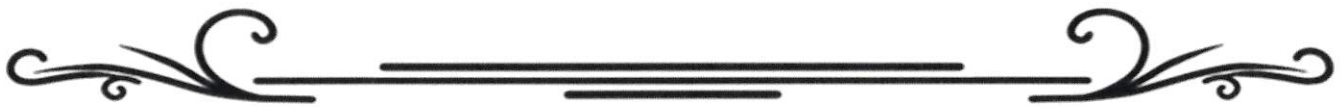

at First Lutheran later this summer!!

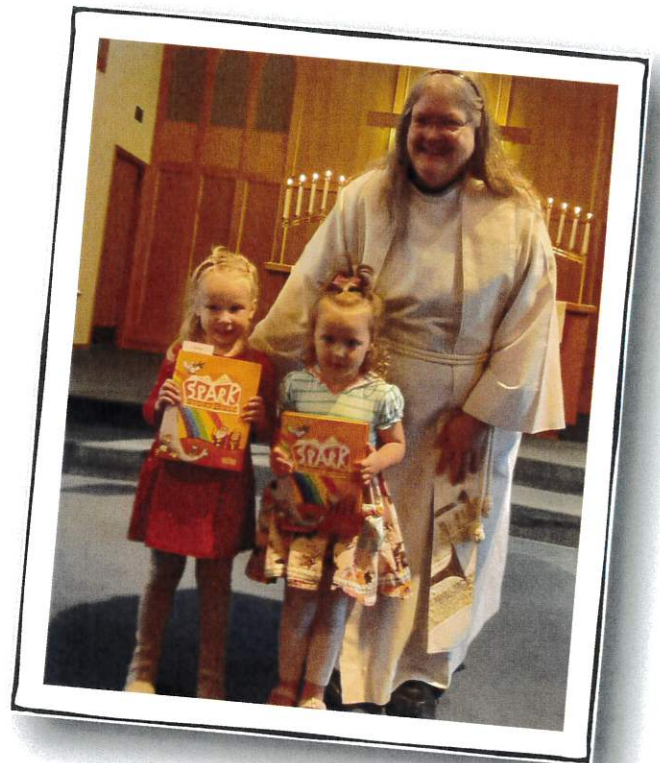
